## Draft By-Law Prepared For Voting in January

 Vestern Municipalities Take a Decidedly Progressive Step andRatepayers Will Not Be Deiayed-Only Minimum Quanti-
ties Desired to Be Named in Contract.

| Toronto will vote upon in January, the blank spaces belng yet to be flled in-some time this week-when the figures are delinitely ascertained: <br> That it shall be lawfil for the council of sald muntcipal corporation of Toronto to execute a contract with the hydro-electric of Toronto, of 24 hhour horsepower of electrical power and energy, or more, for thirty years, for the uses ofithe corporation and the inhabitants thereot, for lighting, heating and power purposes, at from.......to...........or 24 -hour horsepower, ready to be dis- tributed by the sald municipal corporation; such price to inolude all charges for interest, sinking fund for cost to construct, and the cost to operate, maintain, repair, renew and insure the chinery and appliances to be used by said commission." |
