An Act to detach the Township of Euphemia and part of the Townships of Sombra and Dawn from the County of Lambton, and to annex the same to the County of Kent.

WHEREAS the convenience of the inhabitants of the Township of Euphemia and of parts of the Townships of Sombra and Dawn, now in the County of Lambton, will be greatly promoted by annexing the same to the County of Kent and by making certain other changes hereinafter mentioned touching the said Townships and parts of Townships, the inhabitants whereof have by their petitions to the Legislature prayed that the same be so annexed to Kent and such other changes made: Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows: Preamble.

I. The second section of the Act passed in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled, "*An Act to supply certain necessary Legislative provisions not included in certain Acts herein mentioned,*" shall be and is hereby repealed. Sect. 2 of 12 V. c. 79 repealed.

II. The Township of Euphemia shall be re-united to the now Township of Zone, and shall form one Township therewith under the name of the Township of Zone, as it did before the passing of the Act last aforesaid. Euphemia re-united to Zone.

III. That part of the original Township of Dawn which by the section above repealed was annexed to the Township of Camden, shall be detached therefrom as before the passing of the said Act; and all that part of the Township of Dawn as originally surveyed, which lies to the South of the allowance for road between lots numbers twenty and twenty-one in the several Concessions thereof, shall constitute a new Township by the name of the Township of South Dawn. Township of South Dawn.

IV. That part of the original Township of Sombra which by the said repealed section was annexed to the Township of Chatham, shall be detached therefrom as before the passing of the said Act, and the first, second and third concessions of the Township of Sombra as originally surveyed, and the twelfth, thirteenth, fourteenth, fifteenth, sixteenth, seventeenth and eighteenth concessions of the Baldoon Estate in the original Township of Dover East, with the twelfth, thirteenth, fourteenth, fifteenth, sixteenth, seventeenth, eighteenth and nineteenth concessions of the original Township of Chatham, and St. Ann's Island at the mouth of the River St. Clair, shall constitute a new Township by the name of the Township of South Sombra. Township of South Sombra

Zone, South Dawn and South Sombra annexed to Kent. V. The Township of Zone as hereby constituted, and the Townships of South Dawn and South Sombra as above defined, shall be and are hereby annexed to and shall form part of the County of Kent.

First Returning officer. VI. The Warden of the County of Kent shall appoint a proper person to be the Returning Officer at the first Municipal Election, in each the 5 Townships of South Dawn and South Sombra.

Commencement of Act. VII. The foregoing provisions of this Act shall come into force upon, from and after the first day of January, 1857, and not before.
