The 20th Century Missionary fund—A clipping from "The Baptist," dated October 18, 1901. The Autumn assembly of the Baptist Mission Union of Great Britain and Ireland, was held in Edinburgh this year. Dr. McLaren, President, called for a report of this fund, which was read by the Vice-President; Rev. J. R. Wood—"The Union set out to raise £250,000, and have now promised and paid £185,414, and of that amount £121,600 has been paid in, that amount has been contributed by 1,010 Churches connected with the Union—£64,000 remains yet to be raised, and the Woman are asked to help. A Baptist Women's Twentieth Century League was formed and before this Meeting closed, several persons present contributed 13,000 shillings towards the new scheme."
