CROSS-CANADA TOUR BY THE AMBASSADOR FOR DISARMAMENT

The Right Honourable Joe Clark, Secretary of State for External Affairs, today announced the details of a cross-Canada tour to be undertaken by the Ambassador for Disarmament, Mr. Douglas Roche.

The Secretary of State for External Affairs announced that Mr. Roche will visit every province in Canada to address the issue "Beyond the Summit - the Future of Disarmament". Mr. Roche will take a broad internationalist approach to both political developments and specific arms control measures. Mr. Clark said this major tour will provide the opportunity for a productive exchange of views on these issues between the Government of Canada and interested Canadians.
