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


*Parlor, Antique Room*.—Furnished by B. M. & T. Jenkins of 444-446 Yonge St., with Oriental, Elizabethan, Old Empire, Chippendale, Louis XVI., Sheraton, Hepplewhite, Old Adams, and colonial and habitant furniture, tables, chairs, sofas, cabinets, secretaries, mirrors, etc., together with vases, bronzes, clocks, candelabra, old armor and arms, harpsichords, etc.
