MONTREAL, PRESCOTT AND KINGSTON RAILWAY

An Adjourned Public Meeting of the Citizens of Montreal, and others, interested in the construction of a Trunk Railway from Montreal to Prescott and Kingston, was yesterday held in the Hall of the Bonaparte Market, for the purpose of receiving the report of the Committee appointed at the Meeting of the 29th Nov. last. A number of gentlemen from Upper Canada, were present.

The Hon. A. N. Morin, was called to the Chair. E. G. Peary, Esq., acted as Secretary. The Secretary presented to the Chairman, a letter from His Worship the Mayor, the latter apologized for the non-attendance of His Worship, on the ground of indisposition, consequent upon the fatigue and anxieties he had undergone on the preceding day.

John Young, Esq., as Chairman of the Committee, read the following report:—

The Committee appointed at the Public Meeting, held at Montreal on Friday, the 29th November last, to consider the propriety of commencing a Western Railway—

By this route to report—

That having obtained the services of C. S. Gwynne, Esq., Chief Engineer of the St. Lawrence and Atlantic Railway, and of Mr. J. G. Gwynne, Esq., Chief Engineer of the Montreal and Kingston Railway, the Committee have had the honor to receive from them, in conformity with the instructions contained in the resolution of the 29th December last, a full and complete report on the character of the country, and facilities for constructing a Railroad from Prescott to Kingston, on a line parallel with the St. Lawrence, and from Lachine to the same points by the north side of the Ottawa, passing through or near Grenville, and to furnish you with a degree of certainty as to the route of each of these routes. I proceeded, as soon as arrangements for the purpose could be completed, to make the desired examination, and have now the honor to report to you the result of the same.

Previously to entering upon the details, I wish to state, that the examination was of a general character. I received the country as nearly as possible, in the manner in which the definite location of the route would be recommended, as it was practicable to do within the time allowed, and sufficiently exact, to enable you to form an opinion as to the general character of the country, and facilities for obtaining material required for construction, as well as to enable me to arrive at the probable cost of the route respectively.
