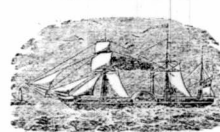

violation of the rules regarding the payment of the public money in this Province. It also appeared from the committee's report that owing to the expense of keeping accounts which prevailed, it was impossible to obtain the exact cost of the printing, but the committee had succeeded in finding that \$28,528.50 had been paid for this service during the last year.

Adding to the cost of public printing for the past year, as given by the committee, the sum of \$3000, which was a fair estimate for the cost of the "Royal Gazette," the amount paid for printing during the year was nearly \$32,000 of public money.
