DID HE TAKE POISON?
Herman Gordon, a Jewish Pedlar, Had a Narrow Escape Yesterday—Was Lingered Caused the Illness.

Herman Gordon, a Jewish pedlar, who lives at 150 Queen-street, narrowly escaped death last night. Shortly after 5 o'clock his wife, Hannah Dr. Johnson of Elm-street, who found Gordon in a critical condition and apparently suffering from the effects of narcotic poison. Dr. Cassidy was also summoned and the two medical men worked upon the sick man for some time. Finally, the doctor pronounced that, after a couple of hours the doctors brought Gordon home and administered his dose of danger. In his possession they found a small pill box containing nine medicine tablets and an unopened box of soap on salt. The doctor asked him where he got the drug, and he told them he had "got it out." He denied having taken any of it, but that his illness was caused by liquor.

MORE FIGHTING IN INDIA.
Zalka-Khels Fired on the Oxfordshire Regiment, Wounding Two Officers and Killing Men.

Calcutta, Jan. 3.—The Zalka-Khels have blocked the road from All Musjid to Ludi Kandi, preventing the establishment of communication with General Sir William Lockhart. The enemy is very active and has fired on the Oxfordshire Regiment, which is engaged in convoy duty at Riber Pass, wounding Col. Plowden and Lieut. Owen. Some of the men were killed, and the task of removing the wounded, had difficulty in getting them to the hospital. Several were wounded, including Capt. Parr, who was wounded in the abdomen. Finally they were taken to the hospital and returned into the walled enclosure, where they are awaiting reinforcements.

GOODS FOR YUKON COUNTRY.
Arrangements Made With Uncle Sam in regard to Customs Matters—Ottawa News.

Ottawa, Jan. 3.—(Special)—Hon. Clifford Sifton states that a satisfactory arrangement has been arrived at in regard to goods entering the Yukon at Dyea and Skagway. Bonding privileges will be granted the United States for similar privileges which have been granted to Canada. Goods arriving at Dyea or Skagway will be sent over the customs on a certificate, and the customs duties will be paid on a return Canadian territory. It will not be necessary to pay customs officers to accompany the goods.
