FIRST EDITION. THE SWIFT TEUTONIC. UNPARALLELED SPEED OF THE WHITE STAR LINE.

New York, Aug. 19.—The White Star line steamer Teutonic arrived at this port this morning with the distinction of having made the fastest ocean voyage on record.

It was quietly whispered before the Teutonic sailed that an attempt would be made to break the record, and the greatest interest in the ship's performance was manifested among her passengers.

During the next twenty-four hours ending Aug. 15 the ship had logged only 409 miles, and those who had any hopes of the vessel's breaking the record in the abandoned time.

Towards noon a crowd of the passengers gathered in the main saloon gallery, watching eagerly for possible developments.

At about 10 o'clock the wind rose to light breeze, and the ship's speed was increased to a remarkable pace, which was continued until the captain yesterday announced at lunch that the ship had just added 317 miles to her credit.

During the trip of the Teutonic, she averaged seventy-four revolutions a minute, though it is said that during the last three weeks of the trip they averaged eighty.

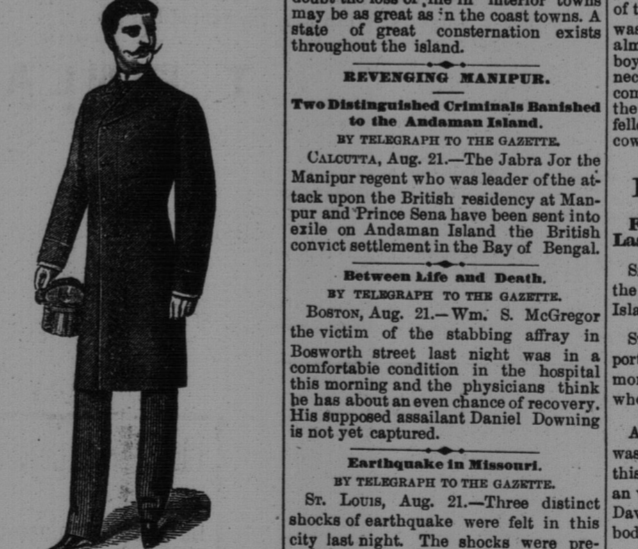
