In a late number of the Courier, we acknowledged the receipt of a small pamphlet, being a letter from the Hon. James Morris, of Brockville, to the Stockholders of the Commercial Bank, M.D. We also stated that we should again notice it.

We now do so, rather, than our contemporary the Gazette treats its readers to a couple of columns on the subject, and takes, what we think, a most strange and unjust view of the whole affair. To enable our readers to judge for themselves, we will give a short account of the dispute.

Mr. Morris tells us, that during the last Session in Toronto, Mr. Cameron, the Cashier in that city, showed him a letter from the Cashier in Kingston, desiring him to obtain, if possible, a share of the Public Account, and requesting him to obtain Mr. Morris' assistance in the matter.

Mr. Morris at first demurred, but afterwards consented to see the Inspector General on the subject; he did so, and made with that gentleman an arrangement of a highly advantageous character.

Mr. Morris then telegraphed to the Kingston Cashier, who approved the transaction, by communicating his desire to Mr. Morris to have the size of the Bills of Exchange, obtained from the Government, reduced. At a late hour on the same day, the Kingston Cashier wrote Mr. Morris an offensive letter, that that gentleman returned it in a blank envelope.

Mr. Morris stated, that in his transaction with Mr. Hicks, he acted not as the servant of the Bank, but as a private individual, using whatever influence he might be supposed to have as a member of the Legislature. He, therefore, assumed, very properly, that the matter before himself and Mr. Harper, the Kingston Cashier, was of a personal character, and that the Directors of the Bank had no right to interfere.

Mr. Morris shortly after returned to his duties as Cashier of the Branch Bank at Brockville, and, while there, received a copy of a Minute of the Board of Directors, stating, in effect, that unless Mr. Morris could give a satisfactory explanation of his return of Mr. Harper's letter in a blank envelope, they should expect his resignation. Mr. Morris immediately proceeded to Kingston, in order to enter into a personal explanation with the Board, but the latter declined to see him.

Mr. Morris then telegraphed to Mr. Cameron, and demanded an explanation in writing, which Mr. Cameron consented to give to him. Mr. Morris then wishing to ascertain how the transaction would be judged of by men experienced in Banking, addressed letters to Mr. Benjamin Holmes and Mr. Ridout, enclosing to each a copy of the explanation which he had previously had before the Directors. By both of these gentlemen Mr. Morris' conduct was completely approved, with the sole exception, that they rather thought he should have sent Mr. Harper's offensive letter to the Directors, than have returned it in a blank envelope to the writer.

Presently the same opinion was given by Mr. P. McGill and Mr. J. Gordon, though these gentlemen think he was right in returning the letter as he did. Mr. Morris afterwards resigned, and is now, we believe, one of the Directors of the Branch Bank of Upper Canada lately opened in Brockville.

Now we shall explain what Mr. Morris did, and then our readers will see whether he deserved the scurrilous treatment he experienced from the Directors, and the injurious language of the Montreal Gazette.

Mr. Harper writes from Kingston to Mr. Cameron in Toronto, requesting the latter gentleman to beg Mr. Morris to see his influence with the Government to get a share of the Public Account. Mr. Morris did so—saw the Inspector-General, who told him that though he could not give him a part of the Government deposit, he would let him have Bills on London for £20,000 or £25,000, 30 days sight, at a rate to be agreed on, to remain in deposit for at least three months, at 4 per cent interest, and then to be charged out, in payment of the current demands of Government. Mr. Harper, the President of the Bank, met Mr. Morris in Toronto, and expressed his great satisfaction in the arrangement.

Two or three days afterwards, Mr. Morris signed with Mr. Hicks, that the Bank should be paid £25,000 at 11 per cent. Bills were to be given for £25,000 and £11,000 sterling. This was communicated to Mr. Harper—Mr. Morris mentioning in his letter that Mr. Ridout had paid the £25,000 on the 4th day before. Mr. Cameron, the Cashier, and Mr. Morris, the resident Director in Toronto, were both delighted with the arrangement, thinking it a most advantageous one for the Bank. But a day or two after Mr. Morris resigned, then Mr. Harper the offensive letter to which we alluded before, complaining that the negotiation had been entered into without the consent of the Board. Mr. Morris, feeling deeply injured, immediately telegraphed to Kingston to beg Mr. Cameron to see his influence with the Government to cancel the transaction.
