LITERARY NOTES. From the Toronto Globe, June 11. APPLETON'S ANNUAL CYCLOPEDIA AND DIRECTORY OF IMPORTANT EVENTS OF THE YEAR 1888. New York: D. Appleton & Co.

The last volume of Appleton's Cyclopaedia proper appeared in 1876, and for the same year and each year since there has been issued a single volume dealing with the occurrences of the year. Present Chief supporter.
From the New York Tribune, Jan. 15, 1874.
Pranced there upon the arena of the
great debate, like a trick mule in a circus,
or a spavined nightmare upon the track of
a beautiful dream—Logan of Illinois.
There was a vision of moustaches, eye-

arches; a large braiding of arms, a pose

American senate was scattered with the

widowed nouns; bachelor verbs
driven to polygamy and polygamy
driven to bachelorhood. Lonely con-
junctions discovered, prepositions scat-
tered, adverbs disheveled and distorted,
and syntax flung into wild disorder. It
was a great day for Logan. He set his
teeth into the language as the untamed
tiger of the jungle takes between his
mouth and paw the wearing apparel of the
wayfarer, and the ripping of it was heard
through all the forest depths. It reverber-
ated to the eaves of the capitol and
sluggish representatives flung up their
eyes and started to the roar with terrific
awe. Some started for the scene, but
upon being told the cause of the
disturbance in the brief com-
munication, "Logan's up," turned
back with full assurance that they
could hear from the speaker all that
was worth hearing. So through two
hours Logan swung his beautiful arms
over the heads of the senate like the booms of a
government derick, while his chin churred
the language like a pile-driver in a heavy
sea, and the baffled reporters made wild
prizes with their pencils to gather up his
regulations for the printer. Ah!
Logan is a great man—a statesman. He
threw his last into a question, whether
it is of finance or of government,
or sticking to the ship, something has got
to come. And you may always know
where to find him—so wide, where he has
always been, drawing pay from the govern-
ment in some capacity. He lacks only
fifteen or twenty things of being an orator.
He has lungs.
