## Baldwin

Reporter Scoop 'Nute and Snoot' Killgallin

EDMONTON (DP) - Edmonton police have detained a University of Alberta student as a suspect in the bizarre ritual murder of Dean Baldwin in his home last night.

From what details are available, Getaway has learned that Dean Baldwin was garrotted about midnight last night with an old gym sock left unclaimed from last year's Pandas basketball team.
