An Act to amend the Act, intituled, "*An Act to Incorporate the Orphan's Home and Female Aid Society, Toronto.*"

WHEREAS it is desirable to amend the Act intituled, "*An Act to Incorporate the Orphan's Home and Female Aid Society, Toronto,*" Be it therefore enacted, &c.,

5 That it shall and may be lawful for the said Corporation in such manner and upon such terms and subject to such Rules and Regulations now made or hereafter to be made by the said Corporation as to the said Corporation shall seem fit, to put and bind out as an apprentice any child or minor under the charge, care or protection of the said Corporation, and that all the provisions of the Act passed in the fifteenth year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled, "*An Act to amend the Law relating to Apprentices and Minors*" shall, so far as may be consistent with the rules of the said Corporation, and with the terms of the apprenticeship, apply to the case of each such apprentice.

Corporation may bind out as apprentices any children under their charge.

15 II. And be it enacted, That the Directresses and Managers of the said Corporation, for the time being, shall in all matters whatsoever represent and have full power and authority to act for the said Corporation; and whatsoever act, matter or thing shall be done or performed by the said Directresses and Managers, for and
20 in the name of the said Corporation, provided the same be not contrary to law nor inconsistent with the By-laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Corporation, shall be valid and effectual.

Directresses invested with full power to represent Corporation in all matters.
