

An Act for incorporating certain Charitable, Philanthropic and Provident Associations, and for the effectual protection from fraud and misappropriation of the funds of the same.

ATHEREAS large and increasing numbers of all Preamble. classes of the community have for some time past associated themselves together for the purpose of making provision for themselves and families, by contributing 5 subscriptions or otherwise, against sickness, misfortune and death, and for the relief of the widows and orphan children of deceased members; And whereas, the accumulated funds of such Associations (owing to the absence of legal protection,) have been subjected to great and 10 serious losses from frauds and defalcations; And whereas it is expedient to encourage habits of providence and forethought amongst all Her Majesty's subjects : Be it therefore enacted. &c.
