This magnificent work was bought some time ago for £48 stg. It is described by Quaritch as follows:—"The finest copy in existence of the Atlantic Neptune. It is bound in two volumes, in old English red-morocco extra, with board borders of emblematic gold holding on the sides, and is in perfect and spotless condition. It came from the library of the ex-Royal Family of Naples, the Bourbons, and there is no doubt it was presented either by the English Government, or perhaps Sir William Hamilton to King Ferdinand. It would be quite impossible to find another copy to be compared with this."

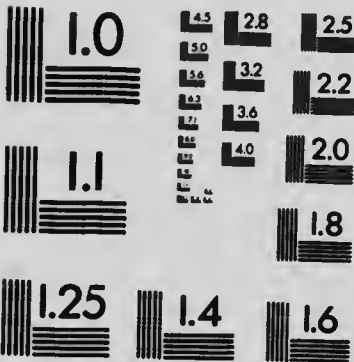
