ST. JOHN AND THE C. P. R.

The Canadian Pacific Railway Co. have made application to the Dominion Government for the same rights with respect to that section of the Intercolonial between St. John and Halifax as the government gave the company last session between Montreal and Halifax.

The Intercolonial railway shall carry freight and passengers from and to points on the Intercolonial railway east of Montreal and destined to or coming from points on any line operated by the lessee which freight and passengers referred to as Canadian Pacific traffic.
