Taught and shown the way by trade unionism. England France, Germany and all the other world powers of the first and second class have recognized the necessity of earing for every citi zen who has outlived the age of useful service and productive use fulness; they have decreed and made provision that their declining years will not be haunted by "old age and want, that illmatched paid." Every one who has rendered service to society is provided for when he reaches a certain age, irrespective of the position he held or the amount of service he rendered. Trade unionism experimented in this direction and demonstrated the validity of the claims it had made. Then the various States mentioned seeing that it was good, made the laws necessary to put the scheme in operation. In this way and in this instance trade unionism led
