In Manitoba Premier Norquy tries

to satisfy the popular demand for the

construction of a railway by declaring

that he values Provincial rights as much

as any one, holds them as dear, and will

go to any length to maintain them. It is

re-marked that in disavowing him, instead

of the Legislature, he is in reality

disavowing the charter again, as he at one time

promised to do, he has thrown away the

advantage the people enjoyed in having a

Lieutenant Governor who would assist

such measures. Mr. Aikens, it is as-

sumed, and without reason, will obey

instructions from Ottawa and reserve all

such measures for the approval of the

Governor General in Council. Mr. Nor-

quy, or his friends, talk of re-negating

the measures and appealing to the Judi-

cial Committee. Such appeal would be

the legal "right" of the Dominion

Government to disallow any Act of a

Provincial Legislature there is no room

to doubt, and it is quite improbable that

any Provincial Legislature would inter-

fere so far as to give advice or offer
