An Act to authorize the Incumbent and Churchwardens of the Church of St. Paul, at London, to sell, lease or mortgage a portion of the block of land on which the said Church stands.

An Act to authorize the Incumbent-and Churchwardens of the Church of St. Paul, at London, to sell, lease, or mortgage a portion of that block of land on which the said Church stands.

WHEREAS the Incumbent and Churchwardens of St. Paul's Church, Preamble. at London, in the County of Middlesex, have in pursuance of a resolution of the said Church, in that behalf, and with the consent and approbation of the Lord Bishop of the Diocese of Huron, petitioned for an Act to authorize the said Incumbent and Churchwardens to sell, lease or mortgage a portion the block of land on which the said Church is situate, for the purpose of raising money to be applied towards paying off the indebtedness of the said Church, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition;

- Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:
- I. It shall be lawful for the Incumbent and Churchwardens, for the Incumbent time being, of St. Paul's Church, at London aforesaid, with the consent and Church-wardens may of the Lord Bishop of the Diocese of Huron, to contract with any person sell and lease 15 or persons, party or parties, for the sale in fee simple, or for a lease for part of the any term of years, or for a conveyance by way of mortgage as a security for money borrowed or to be borrowed, of such portion or portions as they may deem advisable, of the said block of land on which the said Church of St. Paul is situate, -which block may be described as 20 bounded, on the east by the western limit of Clarence Street; on the west, by the eastern extremity of Mark Lane; on the north by the southern limit of Duke Street; and on the south, by the northern limit of North Street, which shall be one hundred feet from the southern limit of North Street, and parallel thereto,—for such price or rent as 25 they may deem most advantageous, and on such terms of payment as may be agreed on.

II. Any conveyance, lease or mortgage to be made in pursuance of Execution of such contract as hereinafter mentioned may be made and executed by deed. the Incumbent, for the time being, of the said Church.

III. All moneys raised by such sale, lease, or mortgage shall be Application applied: Firstly, towards payment of the indebtedness of the said Church, of money and, Secondly, any surplus of such moneys remaining, after the payment from of the said indebtedness, in such manner as the said Incumbent, for the time being, and a special meeting of the Vestry of the said Church, to be called in due form, for the purpose of considering the same, shall 35 decide.

Purchaser, &c., not be bound to see to application. IV. No party paying any money to such Incumbent and Churchwardens, in pursuance of these presents, and obtaining their receipt accordingly, shall be required to see to the proper application of the money.

V. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.
