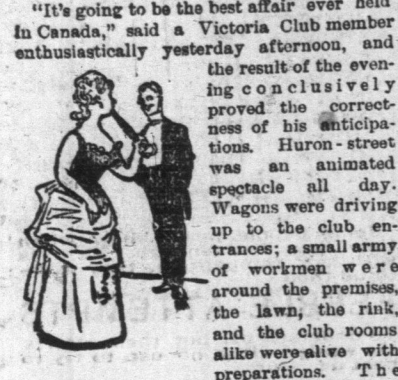

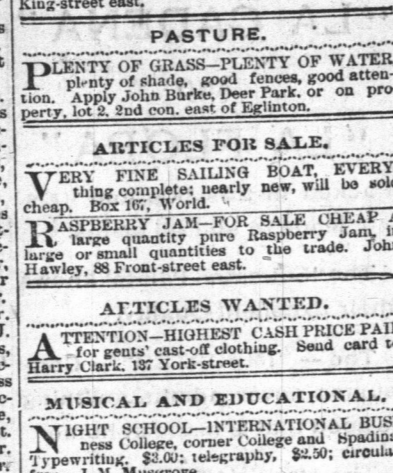

Five Hundred Deaths a Day. CALABRIA, May 27.—Cholera continues its ravages in Calabria.

The Largest Freight Steamship. LONDON, May 27.—The largest freight steamship built was launched to-day at Belfast.

Marsberg Swept by Fire. BRITAIN, May 27.—In Marsberg, Westphalia, to-day a fire broke out in the 18 warehouses here.

Slave Traders Sentenced to Death. ZIMBABWE, May 27.—Judge Sonnenschein has sentenced three Arab slave traders to be hanged for holding a slave market at Lindi within German East African protectorate.

The Strike to Continue. LONDON, May 27.—The Durham miners to-day refused to accept a reduction of 1 1/2 per cent. in their wages as proposed by the mine operators.

Noted French Politician Dead. PARIS, May 27.—Madier De Montjau, the well-known Republican, died to-day.

Cable Flash. Italy will enlarge her army. The prohibition against the entry of Russian arms into Italy has been withdrawn.

A London police constable swallowed two or three false teeth in a fall and choked to death.

Brazil has declined to enter upon negotiations with a view to a commercial treaty with England.

John Redmond, by his physician's advice, has decided to delay his departure for America for a few days.

The King has accepted the resignation of the whole Portuguese Cabinet and has charged Senhor Ferreira to form another cabinet.

The British steamer Harlow of Liverpool struck a rock off the coast of the Azores and sank.

M. Marcell, the Mayor of the Commune aged 82 and his sister, aged 67, have been assassinated in Paris by their grandsons.

The British Government bill relating to alien immigration will be much on the same lines as the American law on the same subject.

The Italian Cabinet resigned yesterday, but the King refused to accept their resignation.

The dissolution of the Chamber of Deputies is believed to be imminent.

John H. Farwell, brother of the late Irish leader, sailed for America on the Teutonic yesterday.

The Belfast Chamber of Commerce has resolved, in view of the present state of the international trade by the McKinley bill, not to take steps towards making an intention.

The Berlin Post explains that Private Leuck, who shot a man and was promoted sergeant, had been killed in his act.

San Francisco, May 27.—The Salvation Army here has decided to organize a cavalry corps for missionary work through the state, and to have headquarters at San Francisco.

The "Hallelujah Cavalry," as it is to be called, will leave here next Tuesday and proceed down the coast to San Luis Obispo.

Among the cavalrymen is one Chinaman, who is to preach the gospel in their own language. The cavalry will camp on the road and military discipline will be enforced.

THE GYPSY QUEEN'S FUNERAL. Her Corpse Robbed in Blue Silk and Decorated with Diamonds.

SPRINGFIELD, May 27.—There were imposing ceremonies at the gypsy camp, between this city and Dayton, last night, when the body of Elizabeth Smith, the Gypsy Queen, who died a few days ago, was sent to Elizabeth, N. J., where it will be buried.

The queen, aged 36, died suddenly in camp. The tribe dressed the corpse in Mrs. Smith's wedding gown, a blue silk and decorated the fingers, breast and ears with diamonds and gold rings.

The queen's funeral, with rings and bracelets will be buried here.

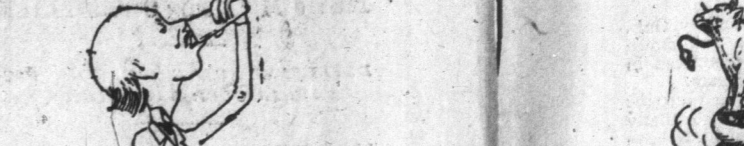

From The Independent Forester. To the Editor of The Mail: Those of your subscribers who have read the letters of Mr. Macdonald, the accomplished attorney of the Confederation Life, will remember how in his first letter he charged me with making statements "that were quite contrary to facts," and though challenged to the proof he has failed to submit a single line of evidence to support a serious charge; on the contrary, with the same marked courtesy for the truth, in his letter which appeared in last Saturday's Mail he again charges me with making a false statement concerning the age of the Independent Order of Foresters. I should like to be able to persuade myself that Mr. Macdonald made use of the above quoted remarks from sheer ignorance of the subject about which he was writing, but in that case I should also have to persuade myself that he does not understand the English language, for it seems to me that no one understanding English and not being so full of the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth, could twist the following words, to wit:

This it will be seen that for a little over one-quarter of the expense the I.O.F. secured nearly five times the number of new members. Every one knows that a large expenditure is necessarily entailed on old life companies in securing new members. If the Confederation Life had secured in 1880 over 8000 new members, instead of only 1700, the I.O.F. would have been established on a basis of 100,000 members, instead of 17,000.

It will also be seen that the I.O.F. paid a much larger sum for insurance and sick and funeral benefits than did the Confederation Life. Indeed, when the care of the sick, undertaken by the members of the order, and the medical attendance of over a thousand court physicians is taken into consideration, the \$125,000 paid by the Confederation Life is not insignificant.

From what has been submitted by Mr. Macdonald and myself I do not think the readers of The Mail will have much difficulty in concluding that the Independent Order of Foresters, as a benefit-bearing institution, at a reasonable cost, is a very sound and profitable investment. I notice that Mr. Macdonald intimates that he has done with this controversy, and believes that your readers must conclude that the I.O.F. is a "furnishing insurance at a much higher cost than can be obtained in any other company," and that the I.O.F. is not operating on sound principles because it charges too little for its insurance. Surely if the managers of the old life companies in their English cry out, "Save us from friend Macdonald," they will be entirely excusable.
