DELEGATION OF FEDERAL AND MANITOBA LEGISLATORS
ON THE GARRISON DIVERSION PROJECT TO VISIT WASHINGTON
JUNE 9-10, 1982

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Mark MacGuigan, announced today that a delegation of federal and Manitoba legislators will be in Washington on June 9 and 10 to express to Members of the U.S. Congress Canada's concerns regarding the Garrison Diversion Project. Federal and Manitoba Ministers have decided that such a visit would be timely, as Congress is now actively considering appropriations for fiscal year 1983 which could include additional funds for the Garrison Project.

The delegation will be co-chaired by the Honourable Lloyd Axworthy, Minister of Employment and Immigration and the Honourable Alvin Mackling, Manitoba Minister of Natural Resources. The other delegates for Manitoba are:
