They Will Have All the Comforts of a Home

When Away—Dining, Sleeping and Kitchen Cars Provided for Them—Handsomely Equipped.

The Grand Trunk Railway have adopted a new and excellent plan, which will do away with the inconvenience of having their repair and road men (when at work on the road) putting up at hotels or returning home.

They have had constructed at the "car shops" here a total of three cars, known as the "road department equipment."

The dining car is arranged with two long tables which stretch nearly the full length of the car. The seats are movable, and can be taken up and stowed under the tables.

Each of the above cars is also supplied with a water tank of 100 gallons capacity, and all are well lighted and ventilated.
