CAP. I.

An Act for confining, for a limited Time, the Trade between the Ports of the United States of America, and His Majesty's Subjects in the Island of Newfoundland, to Bread, Flour, Indian Corn, and Live Stock, to be imported in none but British-built Ships, actually belonging to British Subjects, and navigated according to Law, clearing out from the Ports of His Majesty's European Dominions, and surnished with a Licence according to the Form hereunto annexed.



HEBEAS it is expedient to regu- Preamble. late, for a limited Time, the Trade between the Ports of the United States of America and His Ha-jesty's Subjects in the Juand of Newfoundland: Way it therefore please Pour Wajesty that it may be

enatied; and be it enatied by the King's most Ercellent A 2 Pajetty,

Restrictions on the Importation of Goods into

Hajesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lozds Spiritual and Tempozal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That, from and after the passing of this Ad, and during the Continuance of the same, no Goods oz Newjoundland. Commodities whatsoever Hall be imported or brought into any Post, Parbour, or Place, in the Mand of Newfoundland, or the adjacent Juands to his Wajesty belonging, from any Place of Country belonging to the United States of America, upon any Pretence whatsoever, except Bread, Mour, Indian Corn, and Live Stock, under the Restrictions and Regulations herein-after mentioned; any Law, Culiom, or Mage, to the contrary notwithstanding.

No Bread. Flour, Indian Corn, or Live Stock, to be imported into Newfoundland from the United States of America, excent in licenfed Bruifb-built Slups, Gr.

II. And it is hereby further enacted by the Authority afozesaid, That, from and after the patting of this Aft, and during the Continuance of the same, no Bread, Klour, Indian Cozn, oz Live Stock, Hall be bzought oz impozted, from any Place of Country belonging to the faid United States of America, into any Port, Harbour, or Place of the said Island of Newfoundland, or the adjacent Illands to his Wajcsty belonging, ercept in British-built Ships, which thall actually and bona fide belong to and be wholly owned by British Subjects, and navigated according to Law, and which thall, within the Space of Seven Wonths previous to the Time of such Importation, have cleared out from some Post in Great Britain, of some other Part of his Hajeldy's Dominions in Europe, for which Purpose a Licence Hall have been granted by the Commillioners of His Wajelip's Cultoms in England or Scotland, or the Commissioners of His Majesty's Revenue in Ireland, or any other Persons who may be duly authorised in that Kingdom, respectively, in the Manner and Form herein-after mentioned; which Licences thall continue and be in Force for Seven Ca= lendar Wonths from the Day of the Date upon which they are respectively granted, and no longer.

Time for granting Licences finited.

III. Provided always, and be it enacted, That no such Licence thall be granted by virtue of this Aft after the Thirtieth Day of June, One thousand seven hundzed and eighty=seven.

IV. And it is hereby further enacted by the Authority Master of Veraforesaid, That the Waster or Person having the Charge Licence to or Command of any Ship or Aessel to whom such Licence Officer at Port thall be granted thall, upon the Arrival of the faid Ship or Uessel at the Port, Barbour, or Place in the Mand of Newfoundland, of the adjacent Juands to his Hajesty belonging, where the thall discharge such Bread, Flour, Indian Cozn, oz Live Stock, deliver up the said Licence to the Collector or other proper Officer of the Customs there, having first endorsed upon the Back of such Licence the Warks, Dumbers, and Contents of each Package of Bread, Flour, and Indian Corn, and the Description and Tale of each Sort and Species of Live Stock, on Forfeiture of One hundged Pounds; and the Collector, or who thall give other proper Officer of the Customs at Newfoundland, is a Certificate thereof, Sc. hereby enjoined and required to give a Certificate to the Walter or Person having the Charge or Command of such Ship or Uessel, of his having received the said Licence so endocled as before directed, and to transmit the same to the Commissioners of his Wajesty's Customs in England or Scotland, or to the Commissioners of his Wa= jetty's Revenue in Ireland, respectively, by whom such Licence was aranted.

And it is hereby further enacted by the Authority Goods imafozesaid, That if any Bread, Flour, Indian Corn, of trary to this Live Stock, thall be imported or brought from any Place feited. or Country belonging to the said United States of America, into the said Juand of Newfoundland, or the adjacent Mands to his Wajesty belonging, without the Licence by this Ad directed; or if any other Goods or Commodities whatsoever shall be imported or brought into the said Mand of Newfoundland, or the adjacent Mands to his Wajelty belonging, from any Place or Country belongina to the faid United States of America, contrary to the true Intent and Meaning of this Aft, all such Bread, Flour, Indian Cozn, Live Stock, and other Goods, together with the Ship of Aelfel in which the same thall be so imported or brought, thall be forfeited, and thall and may be feized by any Officer of the Customs in the said Island, and the same, as well as the pecuniary Penalty indicted by

this At, may be sued for, prosecuted, and recovered, in any Court of Aice Admiralty which thall have Jurisdiction within the said Juand of Newfoundland; and, after deducting the Charges of prosecuting the same from the gross Produce thereof, the Remainder thall ve given, One Third to his Wajetty, his heirs and Successors, One other Third to the Governor of the said Juand, and the other Third to the Officer or Officers of the Customs who thall seize and prosecute for the same.

VI. And it is hereby further enacted by the Authozity afozesaid, That this Ait shall continue in Fozce from the Commencement thereof until the Twenty-fifth Day of March, One thousand seven hundred and eighty-eight.

THE FORM OF THE LICENCE DIRECTED BY THIS ACT.

Now be it known that the said [Person's Name] hath Licence to lade on board the said Ship [Ship's Name], at and from any Port or Place belonging to the United States of America, Bread, Flour, Indian Corn, and Live Stock, the Produce of the said United States, and no other Article whatsoever, and to carry the said Bread, Flour, Indian Corn, and Live Stock, to some Port or Place on the Island of Newfoundland, or the adjacent Islands to His Ma-

jesty belonging; and on the Arrival of the said Ship at any Port, Harbour, or Place of Discharge in Newfoundland, or the adjacent Islands to His Majesty belonging, the Master or Person having the Charge or Command of the said Ship is required and enjoined to deliver up the faid Licence to the Collector, or other proper Officer of His Majesty's Customs there, and to indorse on the Back thereof, the Marks, Numbers, and Contents of each Package of Bread, Flour, or Indian Corn, and the Description and Tale of each Sort and Species of Live Stock, on Penalty of One hundred Pounds; and shall thereupon receive a Certificate thereof from the said Collector, or other proper Officer of the Customs.
