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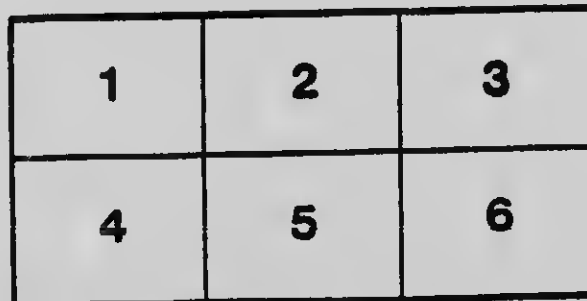
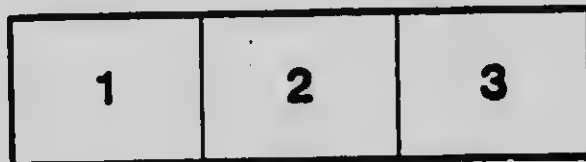
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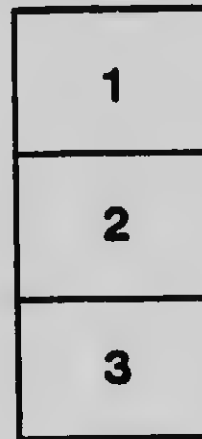

THE CANADIAN CLUB in bidding you welcome to this Gallery would like, in a very few words to explain the nature and objects of this Exhibition.

The pictures that you will see gathered together in this collection have been kindly lent by the owners to the Canadian Club, for the purpose of Free Public Exhibition to the citizens of Hamilton. All of them are valuable, many of them very valuable. Some are the property of our own citizens, and are the choicest specimens from their collections, others are from distant parts of the province. All are of merit, and are lent by their owners solely with a view to promote the love of Art amongst the people.

The Canadian Club's one idea and aim in establishing this Gallery (which will remain open, free to all, every day until the end of September) has been to inaugurate the Public Exhibition of Works of Art in Hamilton, in the hope that the citizens will eventually install a permanent Art Gallery in this beautiful Park which shall be their own property, wherein may be stored a collection worthy to rival those Municipal Galleries, so common in the great cities of Great Britain and other countries.

A box has been placed in the Entrance Hall lettered "For Voluntary Contributions towards the Maintenance of the Art Loan Gallery of Hamilton." This is not to interfere in any way with the free admission to the Gallery, and no one will be asked, or importuned for any subscription; it is there solely to give an opportunity to any one so inclined to help defray the necessary expenses of maintenance, and, (who knows?) perhaps initiate a fund for a more permanent Exhibition.
