ABOUT UNDERDRAINING

Its Many Benefits Described for the Farmer's Benefit.

Many reasons may easily be adduced to show that Nature has herself thoroughly drained a considerable proportion of the soil, but it is probable that in course of time, as sand becomes more valuable, it will be found advisable to artificially drain the greater part of our level or moderately sloping lands that are worthy of agriculture.

The drainage of the soil, by taking away the free water, that occupies the pores of the soil allows for the passage of air and steam, and thus improves the soil.
