President Blair's Address. The chair was occupied by President High Blair, who stated that the object of the meeting was to extend a welcome to their distinguished fellow-colonist, Hon. Robert Reid, Minister of Defence of Victoria.

This break was received with cheers and laughter, and the chairman resumed that in 1858 the board had urged on Sir John Macdonald the advantage of a fast Atlantic service, and ever since Canada and Australia had been mooted the board had taken a lively interest in the question.

The Canadian Government proposed to build up a new mail service which ought to be supported by all Britishers. It would secure the receipt of mails in Australia one week earlier than under the present system. A rapid mail service would secure greatly increased passenger traffic through the Dominion. This means the expenditure of large amounts of money in the country.

The speaker gave details as to the trade of Australia. Her commerce with the outside world amounted to £286,000,000. This 289,000,000 was with Britain and the British Colonies, showing that trade followed the flag.

HOW THE STEAMER ENNS WAS SAVED

Towed Into Foyal By the Wildflower in Heavy Weather, Though That Boat Was Disabled.

PHILADELPHIA, May 7.—The steamship Wildflower, which rescued the disabled North German Lloyd steamer Enns with nearly 500 souls aboard in mid-ocean on March 27, and towed the big liner to Foyal, arrived at this port today from Bordeaux.

The story of the rescue is told by Capt. Livingston of the Wildflower in thrilling detail throughout and depicts the heroism of the master in saving the ship under decidedly adverse circumstances.

On April 2 the welcome spires of Foyal loomed up and more mighty shouts of joy from the decks of the disabled Enns. Reaching the Enns, a moorage Capt. Livingston boarded the Enns, and was at once surrounded by the overjoyed passengers.

A U.S. WARSHIP IN THE THAMES. Britons Will Give a Cordial Welcome to the Greater Chicago.
