FINANCE AND TRADE.

Toronto, Monday, Jan. 14. The export returns for December show that \$15,497 worth of eggs, \$1927 of cheese and \$6223 of butter were shipped to the United States and England from this city.

As an evidence of the sagacity of American manufacturers to secure Canadian trade, we learn that they are now sending goods to this city and dating their invoices three months from March 4.

Business men throughout the province are carrying light stocks, and must soon place their orders for spring and summer goods. Wholesalers are moving cautiously, and have purchased in limited quantities for the coming season's trade, and "cable remittance" will be in order if a revival takes place.

The fact that several city wholesale houses are reducing the number of their salesmen and travelers is based upon a bad sign for retreating property.

Chicago advices to-day report wheat likely to do better. Corn and provisions are good to buy on breaks.

Wheat is likely to rally. To-day 40,000 bushels were purchased in New York for export, and the market here is the market both in New York and Chicago.

The local stock market exhibited considerable life to-day. Federal is looking up, and there was some considerable enquiry for Ontario stock.

WHAT IS GOING ON IN SPORTING CIRCLES ALL THE WORLD OVER.

Western Meet of the Hunt Club—A Sportsman's Convention and the Game Laws—The Canadian-Bred Princess.

A football club is being formed at New Orleans. Soon lacrosse will take a footing there.

The Lansdowne tobogganing club opened their new slides at Montreal on Saturday evening.

Lysander Boy, record 2:10, has been sold for \$300. He was formerly owned by Vanderbilt.

Mike Donovan wants to fight Paddy Ryan with the gloves for \$1000 a side at catchweights, scientific points to count.

The next meeting of the United States association will probably be held at Boston, Mass. The association has \$448.65 in its treasury.

An old time trotting horse named Old Tom, which will be 12 years old next spring, is living at Norwich, Va. He is fit but feeble.

George M. Robinson, of San Francisco, put up a 60-pound dumb bell eighty times with his right hand, the best previous record, made by Breed, of Lynn, was sixty times.

Victoria, McGill and Crystal of Montreal, Ottawa, Quebec, Sherbrooke and Halifax clubs will be represented in the hockey tournament at the Montreal carnival.

Wagner of Hespeler beat Stroud of Hamilton in a fifteen-hand shooting match for \$20 by 14 to 13. The pair have been matched for another shoot at 15 birds for \$25 a side on the 21st inst.

Tom Murray of Germantown, Pa., and Joe McDonald of Montreal, were expected to fight to-day with bare knuckles, but they wouldn't agree on a place for fighting and the affair fell through.

Efforts are being made to get the Australian team visiting England that they are to fight by way of America. If they are to visit Toronto and Montreal, they will be induced to visit the latter city.

The late W. A. Engeman, owner of Brighton Beach race track, was a supporter of the catholic church, to which he belonged. He has left the church a large plot of ground on Coney Island.

Wm. Mahoney, 270 lbs., the other day offered to knock out any man in Billy Madden's place at New York. Jack Dempsey handled the stranger in three rounds, completely annihilating him.

The lessons of the Montreal driving park at Point St. Charles gave the first of a series of trotting machines on Saturday. The meetings are to be held weekly throughout the winter. Here is a suggestion for friend Dugan.

None of the heavy-weight pugilists having responded to Mike Donovan's offer to back John Hughes, the blacksmith, to spar with any of them, barring Sullivan, he renewed it, and will hold Hughes ready to spar all comers at an exhibition shortly to be given.

The race meeting at New Orleans is almost a failure. Inclement weather caused the postponement. Although nominally the meeting has been in progress since Dec. 25 there have been but four days' racing. Last Saturday's events had to be postponed until to-day.

The skating races during the Montreal carnival will comprise contests at 220 yards, quarter mile, half mile, boys' quarter mile, one mile, two miles, and five miles. All the prizes will be gold and silver medals. Particular attention is to be paid to record making.

Great interest is being manifested in England in the Royal Yacht Club's sailing rowing match race. This interest has been stimulated by the question whether Wallace can beat Bubar with ten seconds' start. The impression is that Ross will have to do the best rowing of his life to win.

A report prevailed on Saturday in St. Louis, Mo., that the slinger Sullivan had been shot at Buffalo, Missouri. The report, which was not confirmed, probably arose from a widespread belief that a bullet will get into much more trouble in the wild west.

One thousand hares, or rabbits as they are generally known, were recently shipped from Chicago to England. It is astonishing that this species of game is so popular so little here, both by sportsmen and the public. Rabbits afford a capital winter sport, when eaten by hounds, and make a most delicious dish.

In York, England, in 1799, was printed a book by Dr. John Burton entitled "Ancient Notes of Horse-racing for above Two Thousand Years." It was a full and complete history of the jockeys of ancient Rome, and contained the names of the principal pool-sellers of the age, and the names of the winners of the turf. It appears from it that Julius Caesar once owned a two-year-old and lost a good deal of money in it.

Nearly \$3,000,000 were paid out in the last year in pursing racing races. At some of the principal summer meetings the awards were: Chicago, \$45,700; Cleveland, \$24,500; Buffalo, \$24,500; Hartford, \$22,000; Louisville, \$21,000; Providence, \$21,500; Pittsburgh, \$18,000. Fall meetings: Chicago, \$14,550; Albany, \$14,500; Philadelphia, \$14,500. The grand total paid at seventeen meetings was the large sum of \$311,410.

Angling sports are in their zenith in Jacksonville, Fla. A rod and reel club will soon be organized, and lovers of fishing are arriving daily. Among those who will soon visit the city to enjoy the sport is Hon. W. F. Whitaker, late Canadian minister at Ottawa. He will be accompanied by his wife and a party of Canadian friends, and have boats, a birch bark canoe and fishing, hunting and camping outfit. It is said Mr. Whitaker has tastes congenial with her husband's.—New Orleans Times Democrat.
