The most unprofitable soil can be made productive without the use of manure or fertilizers, though it would be simpler to attempt to improve the land in that manner.

There is no secret in the improving of the soil by the growing of crops for that purpose. Clover is made the basis of all the soil.

When nitrogenous crops are used for improving the soil rotation is advisable. Clover should be grown on every portion of the farm.

The largest portion of the food consumed by the human race is derived from the soil. It is estimated that about nine pounds of digestible matter is required to maintain a steer 1000 pounds live weight.
