







THE KNIGHTS OF LABOR.

A PROBABLE DISAGREEMENT WITH THE TRADES UNIONS.

Close of the Cleveland Convention—Powderly's Influence Weakened—Who Comes the New Executive.

Special Correspondence New York Sun. CLEVELAND, June 6.—The Knights of Labor closed their convention tonight, and by tomorrow noon all will have left town.

To-day the two remaining assistants on the General Executive Board were elected, the places being filled by men of the character of the Order stands in need of, and says were put forward before it into the hands of the Home Club.
