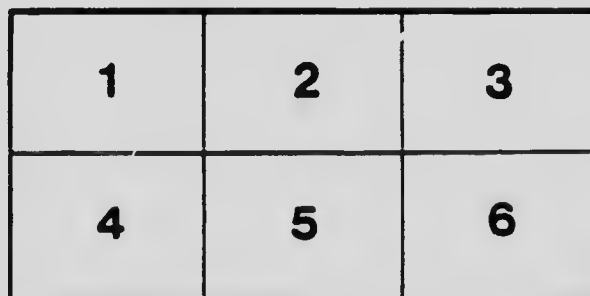
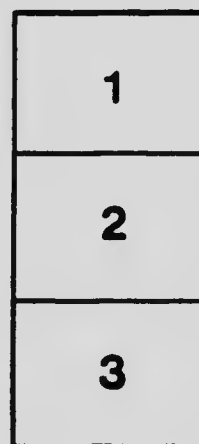

THE unrivalled summer climate: the varied and beautiful scenery of bay and river, lake and country-side, the fishing and shooting privileges; and, above all, the opportunity to spend a few weeks, or the whole of the heated season, in perfect comfort amid the most beautiful and lovely surroundings,—these are the attractions that draw year after year an increasing number of tourists, sportsmen, and summer cottagers to the Maritime Provinces of Canada.

It is not the purpose of this book to deal at length with any one of the three provinces, or any particular place in either of them. There are Tourist Associations in the various cities of the provinces, from which full information may be secured regarding localities; and the various transportation companies can also supply an abundance of information as to routes, fares, hotel rates, and the special attractions of any particular route. The value of publicity is now so fully recognized that a postal card of enquiry will bring ample information to the intending tourist.

The aim of this book is rather to place before the readers a collection of views of scenery from all parts of the provinces. It will be impossible to look them over and become aware of the wonderful beauty and variety of that scenery

without feeling a desire to make a provincial tour, and spend at least a short time amid such delightful surroundings. Happily it is possible to do so with perfect ease and comfort, and at comparatively small cost; for whether one enters the provinces by rail through New Brunswick, or goes by steamer to St. John, Yarmouth, Halifax or Charlottetown, the travelling accommodations are not only comfortable but luxurious.

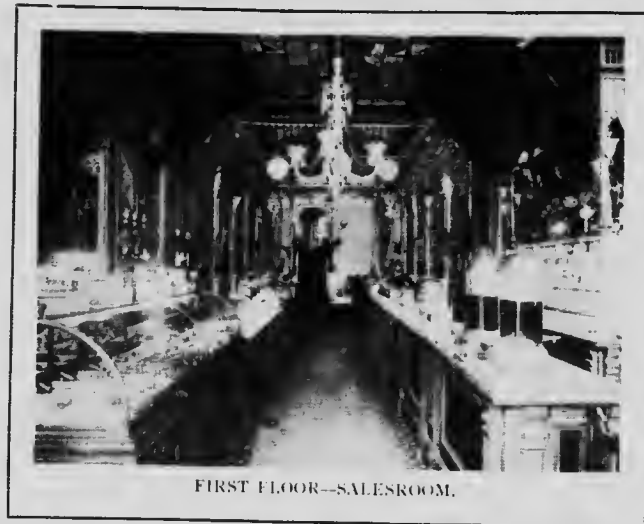

THE Grand Hotel at Yarmouth is one of the notable hotels of Canada, and is without doubt the best in the Maritime Provinces. It is owned by the Grand Hotel Company, Limited—a Yarmouth Corporation. The Grand was built to attract and hold at Yarmouth some of the tourist travel that had previously merely used Yarmouth as a gateway in entering Nova Scotia, and as "a jumping-off place" in leaving it. It has been in the highest degree successful in that design, and its capacity is now taxed to the utmost to accommodate, during the summer season, the appli-



cants for rooms. The house is a handsome four-storey structure of brick and freestone, occupying a site overlooking the harbor and Bay of Fundy. It is built on an ample scale with a spacious office and dining hall, and has every modern hotel requirement and convenience, including electric lighting, call bells and sanitary plumbing. The quality of the accommodations and service at the Grand are of the class that travellers frequently have to pay from \$4.00 to \$5.00 a day for, but here the transient rates are only \$2.50 to \$3.50, with lower rates by the week or season.

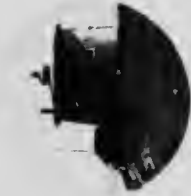

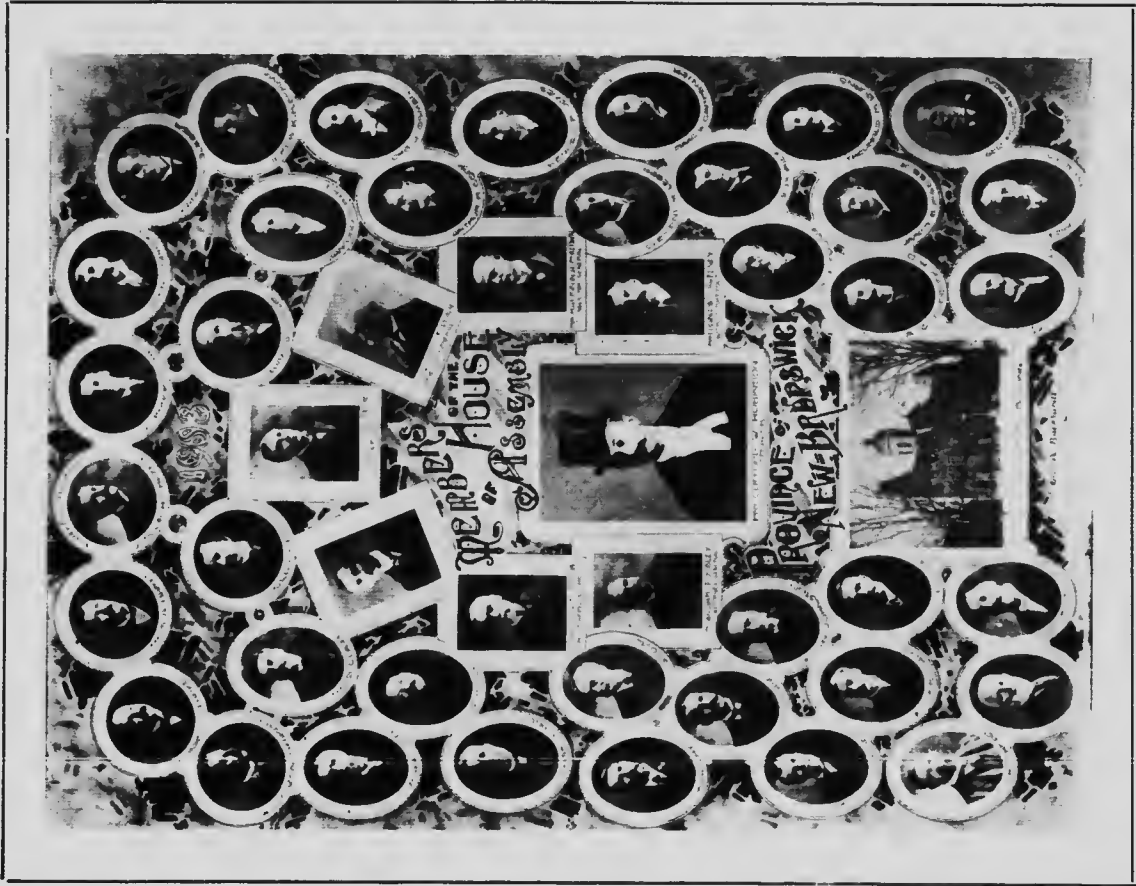

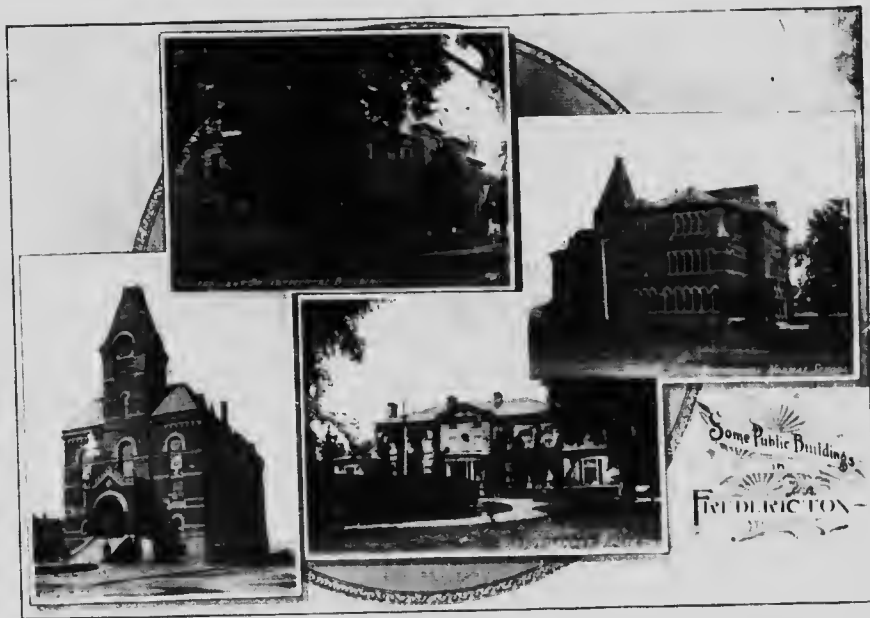

The Carleton is an historic Hotel, for it is said to be the first stone and brick dwelling ever built in Halifax. It is a massive structure, its foundations being six feet through and its walls three feet thick, and they are as substantial and intact to-day as they were when erected nearly a century and a half ago. It was then the private residence of an aristocratic Englishman, and it possesses considerable interest to visitors from the fact that the Duke of Kent, grandfather of the King of England, was for some time a guest there, and for the additional circumstance that in one of the public rooms is the marble mantel that was taken from the French Governor's house at Louisburg at the time that place was captured by the British. The Carleton has recently been improved and extended, and will now accommodate, with the annexes, about 100 guests. Although in the heart of the city it is retired and is added to its home-like air and surroundings.

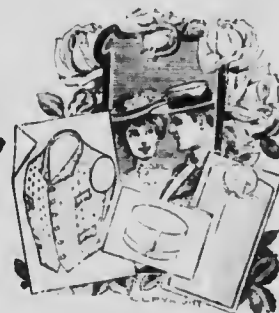

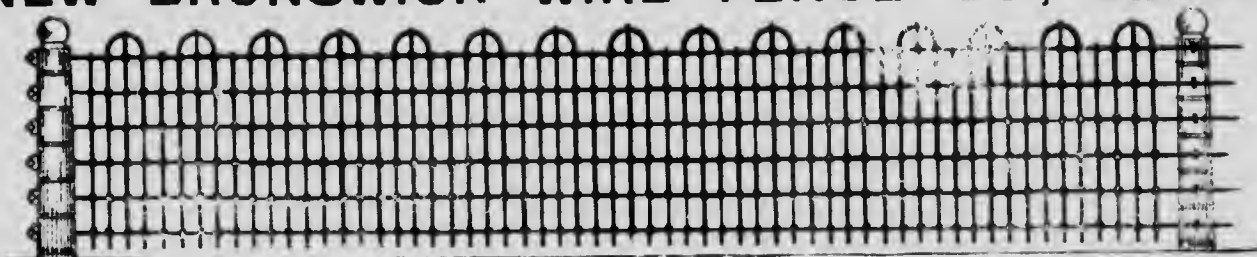

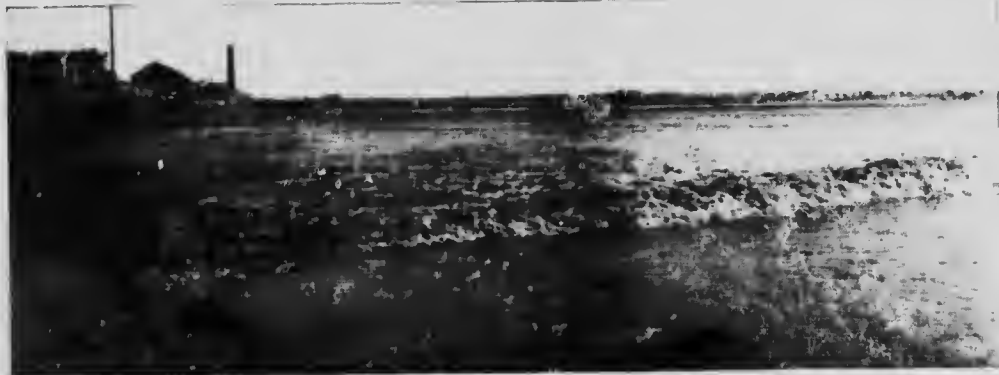
