TO RELIEVING OFFICERS, STIPENDIARY MAGISTRATES, AND OTHERS:-
The expenditure of public money upon hospitals
and similar charitable institutions, the care of outside and similar charitable institutions, the care of outside
patients, and ransportation to and fro has grown to
alarming proportions. Disregard of instructions as to to patients, and ronasportation to and fro has grown to

the

has not only increased the expeniture, but has cuased
inconvenience to the authorities, and unnecessary inconvenience to the authorities, and unnecessary
suffering for the ailing. Room in the hospitas has not, at times, been available for patients arriving here,
and it has been found necessary to send to hoarding-
houses, to await their turn for entering a fospital, houses, to aewait their rurcsary for entend a a hoarding-
many, who would have been better cared for at home many who would have been better cared for at home
during the period of waiting. These and other considerations have made it advisable to state the facts,
and to repeat and add to instructions. nd to repeat and add to instructions. It is the policy of the Legislature and Government
to limit, as closely as possible, the expenditure of pub-
tic to limit, as closely as possible, the expenditure of pub-
lic money in the case of the sick in public hospitals,
and their transportation to and fro, to provision for those patients only who are unabbe to pryy for their
own care, and whose natural protectors are unable to pay for them. The aid given is a charity for the sick
and helpess, and it should only be accepted consistand helpless, and it should only be accepted consist-
ently with self-respect. Those who are able to pay in
whole or in part for their own treatment are expected to do so. Parents are expected to pay for the care of
children, and children for the care of parents, wholly
or partly, where they are able to do so. Only Relieving Officers, or Stipendiary Magis-
trates, acting in lieu of such Officers, have authority to send patients, at the expense of the C
treatment in the public wards of hospitals. Where a Relieving Offic
near, he alone has authority. Where by reason of the remoteness of a Relieving
oficer, and the nature of the malady, delay until such

Officer could act would seem to a Stipendiary Magis-
