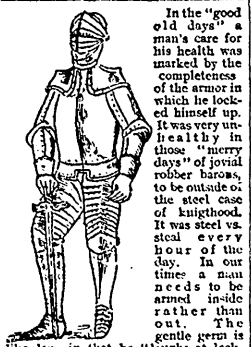

METHUEN MARCHING ON AGAINST THE BOERS?

No Definite News in London But the Lack of it Causes the Belief that He is Advancing to Kimberley's Relief.

FRIDAY, Monday, Nov. 27.—The British Lancers are reported to have attacked and routed the force of Weenen and to have inflicted great loss on the Boers.
