



BY-LAWS.

NUMBER 16.

A BY-LAW

To enable the Municipal Council of the County of Essex, to raise by way of Loan, the sum of £8,000, through the consolidated Municipal Loan Fund of Upper Canada, to defray the expenses of building a Gaol and Court House in the Town of Sandwich, in and for the said County of Essex.

[Passed 20th March, 1855.

Whereas it is necessary to raise the sum of £8,000, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of building a new Gaol and Court House, in the Town of Sandwich, for the County of Essex; And Whereas it is desirable to raise the same by way of Loan upon the authority of the Act 16th Victoria, chapter 22, entitled "An Act to establish a Municipal Loan Fund for Upper Canada," and whereas this By-Law has been approved by a majority of the Municipalities within the County of Essex, at meetings called and held in the respective Municipalities, within the County of Essex, on the 20th day of February, 1855, in conformity to the requirements of the said act to establish a Consolidated Municipal Loan Fund for Upper Canada;

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the County of Essex, in council assembled, under and by virtue of the "Upper Canada Municipal Corporations Act of 1849," and it is hereby enacted and declared, That it shall and may be lawful for the Warden of the said County of Essex for the time being, and he is hereby authorized and

required, for and on behalf and in the name of this Council, to raise by way of loan, upon the credit of the said Consolidated Municipal Loan Fund for Upper Canada, a sum or sums not exceeding in the whole the sum of £8,000, of lawful money of this Province, for the term of 30 years.

And be it enacted, That the moneys to be borrowed under the authority of this By-Law, upon the credit of the said consolidated Municipal Loan Fund, shall be applied to defraying the expenses of the building the Gaol and Court House, in the Town of Sandwich, for the County of Essex, under the direction of the Municipal Council of the said county, and to no other purpose whatever.

And be it enacted, That the Debentures to be issued by the Receiver General of this Province, under the authority of this By-Law, shall be payable at the expiration of 30 years, after the passing of this By-Law.

And be it further enacted, That the principal and interest of the said loan shall be payable by all the Townships, Towns, and Villages in the County of Essex. And the County Treasurer shall in each year apportion the amount to be paid by each, according to the amount of property returned upon the Assessment Rolls of such Townships, Towns or Villages, respectively, for the financial year next preceding that for which the apportionment is to be made.

[The above By-Law was published, for one month, with the following notice.]

The above is a true copy of a proposed By-Law, that will be taken into consideration by the Municipal Council of the County of Essex, in the Council Chamber at the town of Sandwich, in the said county of Essex, on the 20th day of March, 1855, at the hour of 10 o'clock, A.M., at which time and place the Members of the Municipality are hereby required to attend for the purpose aforesaid.

The first publication of this By-Law, in the "Canada Oak" newspaper, published in the town of Sandwich aforesaid, was on the 26th day of January, 1855, and the following time and places have been appointed by the aforesaid Municipal Council for the several Municipalities comprising the County of Essex, for holding the meetings prescribed by

NUMBER 17.

A RY-LAW

To provide for the Current Expenses of the County of Essex, and for the payment of Grand and Petit Jurors for the year 1855.

[Passed 17th July, A.D., 1855.

WHEREAS it is neccessary to provide the sum of £2313 14s. 7d., to defray the Current Expenses of the County of Essex; according to the estimate of the Finance Committee.

And whereas it is expedient to provide the sum of £375 for the payment of Grand and Petit Jurors attending the Courts of Assize, Nisi Prius, the general Quarter Sessions of the Peace and the County Court;

I. Be it therefore enacted, &c, That there shall be raised, levied and collected the said sum of £2313 14s. 7d., upon the whole rateable property in the County of Essex in addition to all other rates and assessments for and during the present year, for the general current expenses of the said County of Essex.

II. Be it enacted, That there shall also be raised, levied and collected the said sum of £375 for the purpose of creating a fund for the payment of the said Jurors attending the Courts of Assize, Nisi Prius, the general Quarter Sessions of the Peace and the County Court in and for the said County of Essex, upon the whole rateable property in the County of Essex in addition to all other rates and assessments imposed for County or township purposes.

III. Be it enacted, That the sum of five shillings per diem be paid to each and every Grand and Petit Juror for each day's attendance at any of the Courts, the Court of Assize, Nisi Prius, the General Quarter Sessions of the Peace and the County Court, and the further sum of 6d per mile for every mile necessarily travelled by such Jurors from his place of residence to the Court House of the said County, according to the pay list to be kept by the Sheriff of the said County.

IV. Be it enacted, That the Sheriff of the said County shall be entitled to receive the following sums and no more, for his services under this By-Law, namely, for every pay list the sum of 1s. 8d. and for checking the sums per diem the sum of 5s., and for certifying and returning the same to the Treasurer of the said County, the sum of 1s. 3d. each.

V. Be it enacted that all sums payable under the third and fourth sections of this By-Law shall be paid by the Treasurer of the said County upon the certified pay lists of the Sheriff.

VI. And be it enacted, That the burthen of the said several assessments above required to be raised, levied and collected, shall be portioned amongst and borne by the several municipalities, in the proportion or shares hereinafter named; and the several sums set opposite to the names of each municipality in the Schedule hereunto annexed, and forming part of this By-Law, shall be raised, levied and collected therein upon the whole rateable property in each respectively for the several rates for which they are designed, and shall be paid over into the hands of the County Treasurer on or before the 14th day of December, in the present

A BY-LAW

To provide for the Payment of Qualified Teachers and Local Superinintendents of Schools for the Year 1855.

[Passed 17th July, A.D. 1855.

Whereas it is necessary, in order to entitle the several Townships, in the County of Essex, to certain sums of money out of the Legislative school grant for the payment of legally qualified teachers, to assess the several Townships in sums equal at least to the sums apportioned after allowing for defalcations and expences for collection; and whereas it is necessary to provide for the salaries of Local Superintendents of Schools; and whereas it will require the sum of £417 7s. 9d. for the payment of qualified Teachers, and a further sum of £54 for the payment of Local Superintendents of Schools;

I. Be it therefore enacted, by the Municipal Council of the County of Essex in Council assembled, under and by virtue of "The Upper Canada Municipal Corporations Act, 1849," That there be raised, levied and collected upon the rateable property in the several Townships, in the County of Essex, in addition to all other rates and assessments, for the payment of Qualified Teachers and Local Superintendents of Schools, the sum of £471 7s. 9d.; and that the sums set opposite to the names of each Township in the Schedule hereunto annexed and forming part of this By-law, shall be raised, levied and collected therein, in the same manner as all other county rates are now by law raised, levied and collected, and the sums for the payment of Qualified Teachers in the said schedule mentioned shall be paid into the hands of the County Treasurer, and the sums in the said schedule also mentioned for the payment of Local Superintendents shall be paid over into the hands of Sub-Trea-
