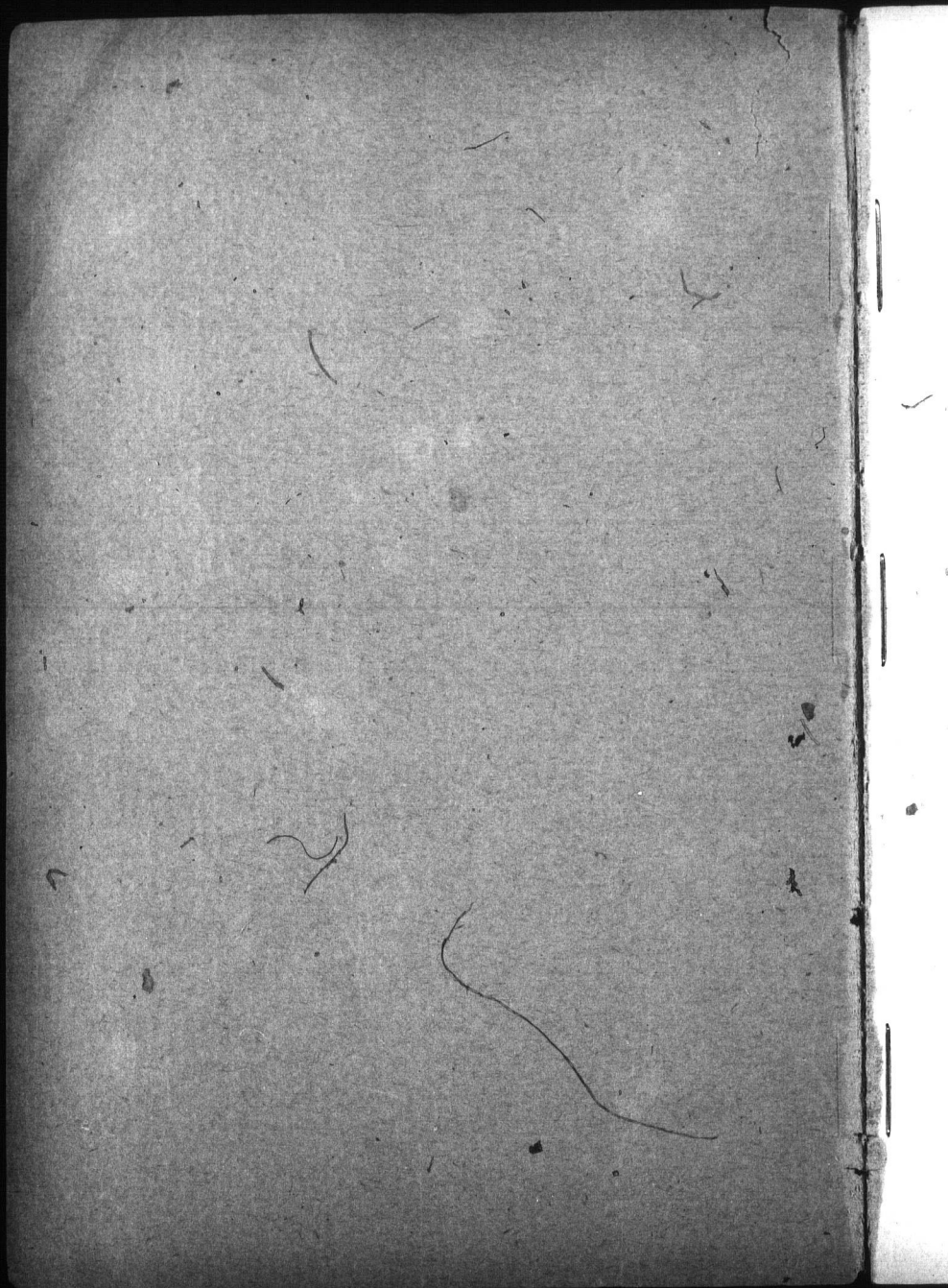

Let our young people give this matter a fair consideration and it is believe that all will gladly do what seems just and right.

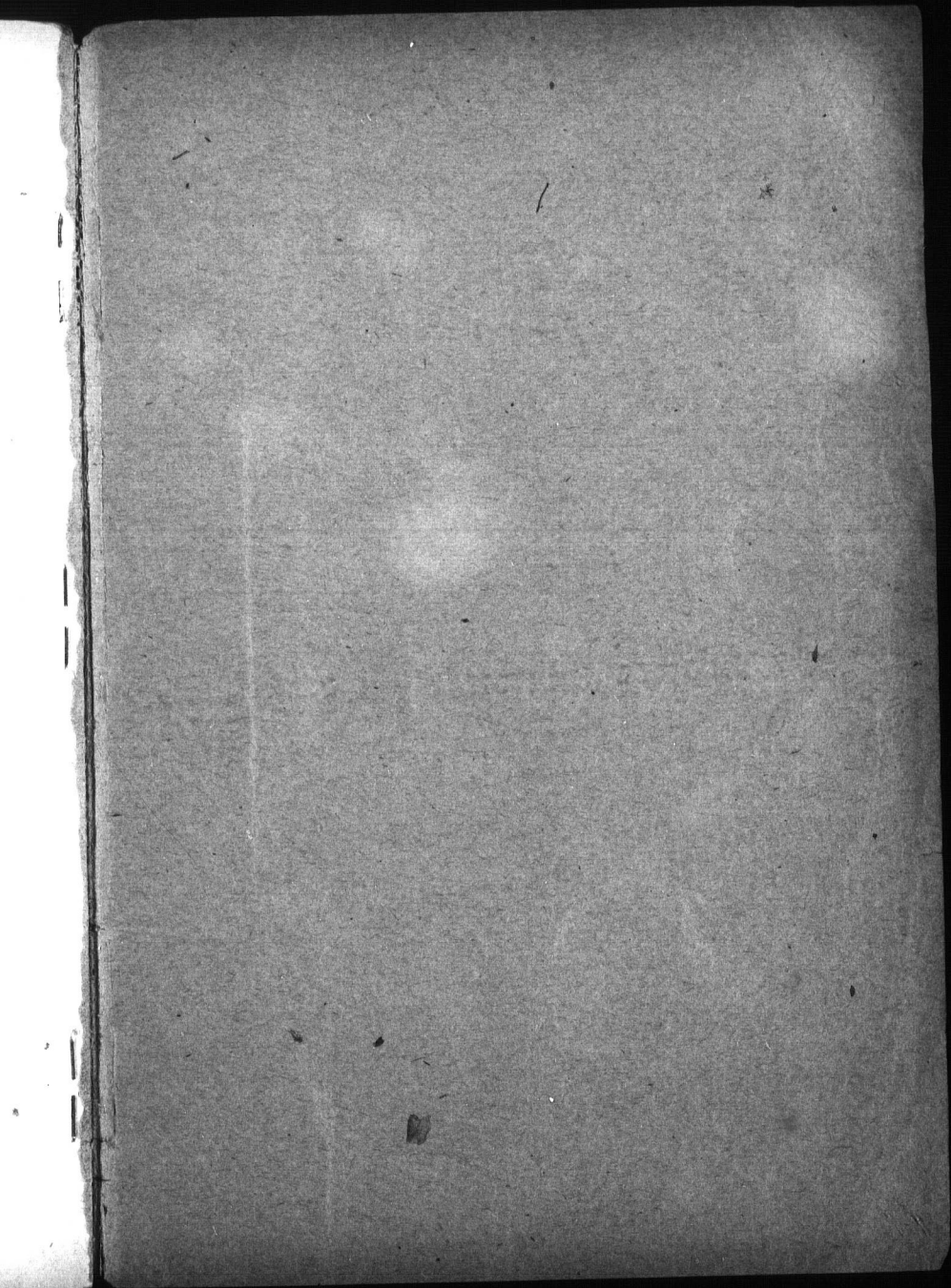

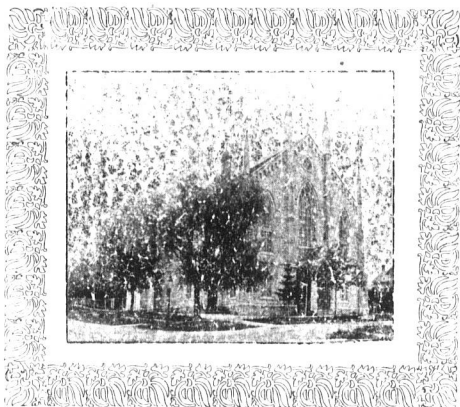
