The promoter of the scheme working on the basis that potatoes contain about \$00', of water, contends that by a process of absorption he can reduce the built of twelve bis of potatoes to one. The mode of procedure is as follows:—The potatoes are cooked, peeled and mashed and placed between layers of paper that had been chemically dried and at the end of three days the paper shall have absorbed all the water from the potatoes.
