CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS.

ONTARIO.

If any change in lumber during the past week, it has been in the direction of a hardening of prices. That all the stock manufactured this season will find a market within a reasonable time is the opinion held by the trade generally. Already large shipments of pine are being made to Michigan points and the Eastern States. Last week several million feet went from the Georgian Bay district to Tonawanda and Saginaw, also a large quantity of lath, which is in good demand. Nearly all the mills are operating day and night, and much of the output is already contracted for. In the event of all the logs reaching the mills, the cut this year will be large. There is some apprehension that a portion of the log production may be hung up, although late rains have improved the outlook. The trade in hardwoods is still quiet. Some dealers report a good demand for elm, others for maple, with the total volume of business below what it should be. Shingles continue scarce, but this will soon be relieved by the new cut.

QUEBEC AND NEW BRUNSWICK.

The spruce lumber market is showing a little more strength. The number of vessels loading at the various ports indicates that the quantity of lumber purchased for foreign shipment is larger than was generally supposed. Two vessels have been chartered to load at St. John for Australia, and one for France. The West Indies is also likely to provide a market for a greater quantity of lumber than last year. Clapboards are higher, selling at \$30 to \$31 for extra spruce, and \$28 to \$29 for clear, on Boston rate of freight. The supply of cedar shingles is not large, and quotations are unchanged at \$2.90 to \$3.00 for extras. The outlook for the log drives is still uncertain. On the Upper St. John about 70,000,000 feet is in danger of being hung up. Should this be the case, the cut of lumber in New Brunswick this year will be unusually light.

UNITED STATES.

The shipments of pine lumber from the Mississippi and Wisconsin producing districts since the first of the year have been over 20 per cent. in excess of the shipments for the same months in 1900. This increase is due to an expansion in building operations, as is forcibly illustrated by the volume of building permits issued. In twenty-one of the principal cities of the United States the permits for April show a gain of over 200 per cent. as compared with April, 1900. The lumber situation is therefore very strong, and it is predicted that prices will be maintained with great uniformity throughout the season. Buffalo and Tonawanda are shipping

by water to the east, where the demand is increasing for both building and manufacturing purposes. Stocks at Tonawanda are badly broken, but cargoes now arriving will help out in this respect. The first cargo was received on May 10th, from the Georgian Bay district, and consisted of 2,000,000 feet of pine. A peculiar circumstance has risen in respect to box lumber. At the mills it has been advanced, while in the eastern market prices have fallen off from fifty cents to one dollar per thousand. In the Saginaw valley there are no large stocks of pine in first hands. Log run ranges from \$16 to \$25, box from \$12 to \$16, and mill culls from \$12 to \$13. An improvement in the demand for quartered oak is about the only change in the hardwoods, which exhibit much less life than pine and spruce. Shingles and lath continue scarce and strong. In Chicago No. 1. mixed pine lath brings \$2.75 by cargo, and No. 1. white pine \$3.25.

GREAT BRITAIN.

The import of sawn and hewn timber into the United Kingdom during the four months ended April 30th was 637,854 loads, compared with 571,906 loads in the corresponding period of last year. This increase is not healthy, in view of the large stock and the general uncertainty of the market. Trade is exceedingly quiet, and buying is being done in a hand-to-mouth manner. The agents of shippers are not forcing sales, believing that such a course would result in depressing the market. One or two Swedish shippers are said to have made low offers and to have closed contracts at £8 10s to £8 15s for battens c.i.f. London. Spruce deals have exhibited further weakness, but it is said that large quantities have been purchased to arrive, and this stock is likely to be held at firm prices. Pine prices have been sustained, but with difficulty, as there is a large stock on the London and Liverpool markets. The stock of square and waney pine at Liverpool is about 2,500 cubic feet larger than one year ago.

J. W. Munro, of Pembroke, Ont., expects to saw 9,000,000 feet of pine lumber this season. Last winter he took out 16,000,000 feet of logs in addition. He is also shipping 500,000 feet of square timber to Great Britain.

STOCKS AND PRICES.

The bark *Suitelma* is loading lumber at Vancouver, B.C., for the west coast of South America.

Vigars & Company, of Port Arthur, Ont., have a contract to supply the C.P.R. with a considerable quantity of timber.

B. Stackhouse, operating for Robert Moore, has succeeded in getting a drive of 1,500,000 feet of pulp logs in safe waters. The logs are for the St. John Sulphite Fibre Co., of St. John, N.B.

The first raft of square timber for the season passed through the Calumet slides last week. It comprised 145 cribs, and was taken out by Hurdman & Company, of Ottawa, from the old Bronson limits on the Antoine creek, near Des Joachims.

William J. Noble, who is operating on the Upper St. John for A. Cushing & Co., has his drive of 10,000,000 feet of logs in corporation limits. Cucliff Bros., who have 12,000,000 feet for Murray and Cushing, of St. John, consider that they are likely to get out safely. Everett Parker has a drive of 3,000,000 feet on the Dunganon, and is reported in safe waters. The South-west Miramichi drive is getting along satisfactorily.

THE GLASGOW MARKET.

Messrs. Edmiston & Mitchells, in their last circular, review the Glasgow market as follows:

WANAY BOARDWOOD.—First-Class.—The stock of large average wood is now much reduced, and buyers are so much opposed to buying small wood, which they think unprofitable, that transactions have been few and far between. There are some enquiries in the market, however, but consumers are anxious to await fresh arrivals. 19-inch Wanay has been sold at 2s. 11d. A parcel of square 40 cubic feet brought 2s. 7d. Second-Class.—This wood is very scarce. 17-inch of good quality is worth 2s., and 18-inch 2s. 2d.

RED PINE.—There is no enquiry. The nominal value of 45 cubic feet average wood is 1s. 9d.

OAK.—A few small sales have taken place during the month, and 65 cubic feet average wood is worth 2s. 11d.

ELM.—Continues to be enquired for, and

further sales have taken place, 45 cubic feet average at 3s. to 3s. 3d. Soft elm is hard to sell, and meets with little enquiry.

BIRCH.—Quebec.—There is practically no stock of wood in the market. Lower Port.—We hear of a sale of 300 logs 15-inch average at 17d. "ex-quay." Nearly 3,000 loads of birch planks have come to hand by St. John's steamers, all of which have been taken delivery of "ex-quay." The value of same is £9 to £9 10s. c.i.f.

ASTH.—The stock on hand is trifling, and consists mostly of small wood. Prices range from 2s. 1d. to 2s. 2d. for 13½ to 14-inch average.

DEALS, &c.—Business during the month has been quiet, though the consumption from public yards has been fairly well maintained. Prices are unaltered, though a few lines of pine deals and sidings have been cleared at easier prices to close consignments. Current values are: Broad First Pine Deals—£26 to £29; 11-inch, £24 to £26; ends and non-dimensions, £18 to £22. Second Pine Deals—11-inch and up, £20 to £22; non-dimensions, £13 to £16. Third Pine Deals—11-inch and up, £12 7s 6d to £13 10s; ends and narrows, £8 10s to £10 10s. Fourth Pine Deals—11-inch and up, £10 10s to £11; narrows, £9 to £10. Red Pine Deals—9 and 11 inch, £12 to £12 10s.; narrows, £9 to £10. First Pine Sidings and Strips—£15 to £21, according to specification. Spruce Deals—9 inch and up, £8 5s. to £9 5s.; 7 and 8 inch, £7 5s. to £8. N.B. Pine and Spruce—7 and 8 inch, £7 to £7 10s.; 9 to 11 inch, £8 to £8 15s.
