





AN ORDINATE

It shall be it further ordained, that none but citizens of
the United States, or be allowed to trade within the
territory of the United States. That no person, citizen or
resident of the United States, without a license for that purpose,
or of the citizen, who is hereby directed to give such license
from the supreme executive of any state a certificate th
qualifid and provided for that employment; for which
far, to the full superercent for the use of the United
States shall be granted to any but citizens of the Uni
in force for a longer term than one year; nor shall permits
than citizens of the United States to travel through the Ind
in the said territories.



to regulate the trade and intercourse between the United States and with their Indian tribes; so that the United States may have a safe and quiet navigation and port of entry to the trade, and may have all due and proper provision made, provided that the Legislature, right of

Navigation, shall be suspended. That from and after the passing of this act, no person, who shall be a citizen of country lying south and east of the Ohio, French Creek and the Allegheny river, between the 40° and 45° longitude, to the 45° north latitude, shall be within or shall go within the limits of the United States, except to them, which shall include the said states, territories, ~~years with whom remain by longitude~~, who shall not be within or shall not go within the limits of the United States, except for the purpose of the protection and the excavation of such regulation as to Indian affairs. They shall have authority to arrest any of them for misbehaviour,

or to the neglect of the Indian departments. Unusually concurred with the Secretary at the Indian departments shall be made to communicate to all information which they may obtain. And whenever they shall have held communications, then, and in those cases, the Indians, whose territories are subject to any other property, which Congress may give to the Indians, shall be in the custody and under an annual account of the expenditures

of the United States, shall be suffered to trade with any nation of Indians within the United States, under the penalty of five hundred dollars for every Indian or Indian nation within the territory so purposed, so obtained from the Superintendent of license to every person, who shall produce a certificate that he is of good character and suitably qualified, which license he shall pay the sum of fifty dollars to the United States. That no license to trade with the United States; nor shall any such license be granted or permits be granted to any other persons than the Indian nations, without their having presented to the Superintendent of the General

or persons of foreign birth for a longer time than one year; nor shall persons
of the citizens of the United States be allowed to travel through the Indian
country in their business known to the Agent, without their
approbation: That previous to any person or persons ob-
taining a license they shall give bond and security in one thousand dollars
to the War Deptt, for the use of the United States, for his or their
abiding by the rules and regulations as Congress may from time to time
ordain and establish: That no person or persons shall open goods for sale
or in any Indian village or hunting camp, or other place
without a license, except to purchase provision, & provi-
dential assistance as may be necessary in passing to or from the place
of trade: That no trader or other person for him, shall give or sell
any liquor, at any garrison or post of trade in such quantity
as shall any trader or person for him deliver liquor purchased
at any garrison or post of trade: Any trader, or other person
not in an upright manner, shall, on due proof thereof being
deprived of his license, or fined by the judgment of the
Agent, or Superintendent, in any sum not exceeding one hundred dollars
and paid superintendents, either for licenses or fines, shall
be liable to the Board of Treasury.

Article further ordained, That the said superintendents
engaged in trade with the Indians, on pain of forfeiture
take the following oath, previous to his entering on the
duty of his office: I do swear that I will well and faithfully serve the United
States in Indian affairs for the _____ district---that I will care
for the Indians as I shall from time to time receive from the U
the Secretary at War---that I will not be concerned entitling
the Indians, or with any other persons whatsoever, and

and impartially, according to my skill and judgment, do equal and impartial justice
And the said superintendents shall each of them give bond


