

### DEGREES.

Students who complete the course and obtain an average not lower than 50 at the Easter (sessional) Examinations are entitled to the Degree of B. A. Candidates for this Degree may take French instead of Greek.

A Bachelor of Arts, of at least three years standing and of good reputation, who produces a thesis satisfactory to the Faculty on a literary, scientific, or philosophical subject, is entitled to the Degree of M. A.

### BUILDINGS.

The College building is large enough to receive from 80 to 100 Students as Boarders, and many more in the class rooms.

It is heated throughout by hot water, and the accommodations for the Students have been found satisfactory by the Students themselves. The eastern wing of the building was erected in 1880, and the rest in 1888. A Gymnasium was erected in 1887.

#### CONTRIBUTIONS, ETC.

The Parishes of the Diocese contributed last year \$6,251.45 to the Building Fund. The late Samuel Campbell, Esq., of Margaree, C. B., bequeathed \$50; the Parish of Friar's Head contributed \$200 to the Endowment Fund; the Hon. Sir J. S. D. Thompson \$150 to the Building Fund.

John E. Somers, M.D., of Cambridge, Mass., gave a valuable set of Chemicals and of Re-agent bottles for the Laboratory.

The Hon. Senator McDonald, of C. B., gave a collection of sixty fossils to the Museum, and several statistical books to the Library.

The Hon. Angus McGillivray gave a copy of Whewell's Philosophy of the Inductive Sciences to the Library.

Mr. A. J. G. McEachen gave Froude's History of England, and several other books to the Library.

## LADIES' ACADEMY.

---

This department of the Academy is conducted by the Sisters of the Congregation of Notre Dame, in the Convent of St. Bernard, Antigonish, and was first opened in November, 1883. Within five years forty-nine of its pupils obtained Provincial License, Grades D, C, and B.

The Gold Medal of the Institution, designed for the Graduate Course, is awarded to pupils who obtain Grade B; the Silver Medal of the Undergraduates to those who obtain Grade C, and a smaller Silver Medal to those who obtain Grade D.

Some of the Science Classes are taught by Professors from the College, and the Convent, as well as the College, uses the Apparatus mentioned on another page.
