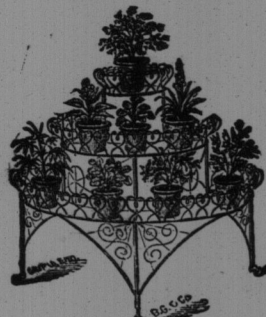

Hold in Place by Two Men—All the Arrangements Were Made—Had the Belt Slipped off the Result Would Have Been Catastrophic.
