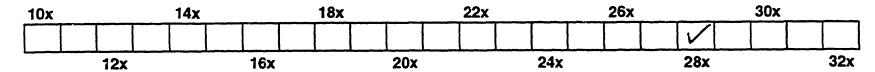

BILL.

An Act to explain and amend the Act intituled "An

"Act to make better provision for granting Li-" censes to Keepers of Taverns, and Dealers in

" Spirituous Liquors in Lower Canada, and for

"the more effectual repression of Intemperance."

HEREAS it is expedient to explain and amend Preamble the Act passed in the Session held in the fourteenth and fifteenth years of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act to make better provision for grant-"ing Licenses to Keepers of Taverns and Dealers in " Spirituous Liquors in Lower Canada, and for the "more effectual repression of Intemperance" in so far as the same relates to the Cities of Quebec and Montreal:

Be it enacted, &c., That so much of the Act cited Partial repeal 10 in the preamble to this Act as may be inconsistent vic. c. 100 with the provisions of this Act be and the same is hereby repealed.

II. And be it enacted, that no license shall be Certificate for granted to any person for keeping an Inn, a Tavern, Quebec or a Temperance Hotel, or any other House or Place of Montreal to be public entertainment, in any Ward of either of the Electors dosaid Cities of Montreal or Quebec, unless the person miciled in the ward and applying for the same shall produce to the Revenue named as such Inspector, a Certificate in the form expressed in Schedule (B.) annexed to the said Act, signed by fifty Municipal Electors, actually domiciled in such Ward, and having their names inscribed as such on the voter's List, then last made and completed, and also signed by the Mayor and City Clerk, as required by the said Act.

III. And be it enacted that it shall be the duty of City Council the City Council of each of the said Cities respectithe signatures vely in every case in which any such Certificate shall are really be presented to it for approval or confirmation to en- Electors. quire and ascertain whether or not the same be in fact signed by fifty Municipal Electors, actually domiciled in the Ward in such Certificate mentioned and having their names inscribed as such on the voter's List then last made and completed as aforesaid, and in default of the same being so signed to withhold its confirmation or approval thereof.

IV. And be it enacted, that it shall be lawful for on oath to the such City Councils, and they are hereby required, to exact proof or oath of the authenticity of such signatures, and of their being those of persons domiciled, and having their names inscribed as aforesaid, in each of such cases as aforesaid.

Name of ward to be inficate and License.

V. And be it enacted, that in every such Certificate serted in certi- and also in every License granted in virtue of such Certificate, the Ward of the City to which the same relates shall be stated; and the same shall be null 10 and void and of no effect whatever beyond the limits of the said Ward.
