Started with Great Pomp—One of the Most Memorable Events in the History of Canada—Tens of Thousands Present—Representing All Classes of Citizens—The City Crowded with Mourners.

KINGSTON, June 11.—The mortal remains of the late Sir John Macdonald were committed to their last resting place to-day. The day was a memorable one for Kingston. It marks an event that cannot be forgotten from the annals of the city. A historic spot and thousands in the coming days will make pilgrimages here to view the resting place of the greatest governmental ruler Canada ever had in her history.

The remains were interred in the presence of a large number of the most distinguished men of the province. The interment was held at 10 o'clock in the morning. They came from all parts of Canada. The entire morning was spent in waiting for the arrival of the cortege. At 10 o'clock the remains were placed in a hearse and proceeded to the cemetery.
