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GENERAL NEWS.

It is stated that the recent massacres in China are the outcome of a formidable revolutionary movement. An assault on Peking is threatened.

George Youngclaus, who had extensive dealings with the cheap restaurants, has been arrested at Chicago for selling horse-flesh labelled beef.

The wear upon the Cape Cod coast is shown to be at the rate of 752,756 cubic yards per year, or an annual wear of the coast equal to a distance of about eight feet.

In Peru, near the village of Galera, which is perhaps the highest inhabited place on earth, more than 15,000 feet above the sea level, a tunnel nearly 4,000 feet in length is being bored through the mountain peak for railway purposes.

The tunnel is about 600 feet above the perpetual snow line.

Daniel Montoury, an old man, resident in Trenton, Ont., was arrested there on Tuesday night charged with killing a boy named Thomas Courtney.

It is stated that on Sunday night, the 8th inst., Montoury was walking along the street carrying a bag of fishes when the boy kicked the bag and broke the crockery.

Montoury knocked the boy down and kicked him three times in the stomach. The boy took to his bed and on the following day he died.

Sixteen years ago a young Hungarian emigrated to America. He was industrious and saved \$3,000, which he carried back to his old home, having converted it into land and a house.

On arrival at home his father recognized him and was told of the money, but the man's identity was concealed from his mother, who in searching the supposed stranger's room, found the gold.

The woman got a knife and butchered her son, and when the truth was revealed to her in the morning she fell dead.

A citizen of Salt Lake City sued the city for \$5,000 damages for injuries sustained in falling on a defective sidewalk in that city. The citizen was pretty drunk at the time he fell and admitted the fact to the court.

The city set the defence of contributory negligence. The plaintiff's lawyer laid down the very plain and plausible proposition that a "drunken man is as much entitled to a good sidewalk as a sober man, and is much more in need of it."

The jury was still wrestling with the logic of the plea at last reports.

Perhaps the most interesting warlike in Maine is a Union flag made from the underclothes of the prisoners at Salisbury prison. The prisoners had set a day to burn which they intended to rise and overpower the guards.

But before the day arrived, orders came for them to be exchanged. The flag was brought home by Lieut. George B. Kennington of Boothbay, a member of the 6th Maine, whose property the flag now is.

General Booth has nominated his daughter, LeMarche Booth, to succeed himself in command of the Salvation Army. In so doing he passes over Lt. Gen. Bramwell, who naturally expected to succeed Booth some day.

The general gives the reason very briefly: "Women are the best rulers," he says. "If you refer to the capacity shown on several occasions by Queen Victoria, you will agree with me that she ruled while her advisers were seeking how to act."

Outlived His Sentence.

Longevity of a Man. Condemned to 100 Years Sentence.

A certain housebreaker was sentenced in the latter part of the last century in France and under peculiar circumstances to 100 years in the galleys, and strange to relate, this man recently made his appearance in his own native province at the advanced age of 120, he being about 20 years of age when the sentence which condemned him to so dreadful a punishment was passed.

It is difficult to conceive what the feelings must have been to which he returned, as soon as emancipated from the shackles which had enthrall him for a century, to breathe once more the cherished air of the scenes of his infancy.

Bourg, in the department of Am, was his native home; but time had so much changed the aspect of the whole place that he recognized it only by the old church of Bourg, which was the only thing that had undergone no alteration.

He had triumphed over laws, bondage, man, time—everything. Not a friend had he left; not a single being could he hail as an acquaintance; yet he was not without experiencing the homage and respect the French invariably pay to old age.

For himself he had forgotten everything connected with his early youth; even all recollection of the crime for which he had suffered was lost, or if at all remembered, it was but as a dreary vision clouded with thousand other dreary visions of days long gone by.

His family and connections for several generations all dead, himself a living proof of the clemency of heaven and the severity of man, regretting, perhaps, the very wrong which had been familiar to him, and half wishing himself again as among the wretched and suffering beings with whom his fate had been so long associated—well might he be called the patriarch of burglars.

The schooner Belvidere, from Parboro with coal for St. John, went ashore between Horseshoe Cove and Cape Spencer and is a total wreck. The Belvidere was built at Diligent River in 1882 and was 100 tons register. She was owned by Captain Joseph Newcomb, of Parboro, and was insured for \$2,000.

Timothy Boyle aged about 60 years of New Ireland, Albert county, while doing trading in the store of A. H. McLean & Co. Monday afternoon, dropped dead of heart disease. Medical aid was promptly on hand, but no avail. He was a well to do farmer, and leaves a wife and large family—Mention Times.

Johnston L. Miner, who is taking a theological course at Wolfville, held divine service in the hall on Sunday evening last, and those present were fully convinced of his probabilities as a minister of the gospel.
