BOSTON, May 12.—The Herald's London says: Parnell, Kelly and Davitt have gone to Paris to see Egton. Fears are entertained among the leaguers lest Parnell's and Davitt's conciliatory course will alienate the sympathy and cash of the Irish in America. The report that Parnell has sought the protection of the police is unfounded. Members of the league who are in America get threatening letters daily. They are supposed to come from Parnell. The leaguers mean to have a new party organized to act with more vigor than ever employed, even if every man is suspended.

**MARCELLANEOUS NOTES.**  
LONDON, May 12.—A Dublin despatch says the police and people are beginning to discredit the theory that Irish Americans were imported to murder Cavendish and Burke. This leads to the deduction that some of the fugitives is implicated in the crime. The great hope is that the reward offered will induce some member to become an informer.
