

The coal bore on Mr. Booth's land is down now beween 300 and 400 feet.

A Japanese, driving a load of hay down the Divide on the 18th ult., fell from his seat and was killed, the ragon wheel passing over his head.

The flag at the Public Hall flew at half-mast ouring he week preceding the Queen's funeral; the belt was alled on the Saturday, and a memorial service held in the Sunday, the church being draped in black.

A terrible mining accilent occurred at Union on he 14th alt., by which between 60 and 70 miners, more han half of them white men, were buried alive 800 eet beneath the surface. The explosion was followed a fire, which prevented all possibility of rescue.

There will be a service at St. Mark's each Wednesisy at 7:30 p.m. during Lent. A few changes are to semade in the Sunday services, of which notice will segiven on printed cards.

A memorial window to Queen Victoria is to be skeed in St. Mark's Church at the western end, over he fout. Mr. Cecil Abbott is collecting for it, and as raised thus far about \$50. When the subscription is completed, the contributions will be duly actionwhedged.

Lenten self-denial envelopes have been issued as smal, and the Bishop is very anxious that all church numbers should this year do their utmost to help the dission Fund of the Diocese. 
