Chear Floor.—Albany and Troy have been visited with a terrible flood. The water rose so tapidly that all those working on the docks and piers were compelled to retreat hastily. The citizens were engaged all Sunday night last in saving so much of their property as possible from rini, but after all their exertions it is feared two millions of dollars worth has been destroyed. At 6 clock Monday morning, the water was three feet higher than was ever known before. The whole of the lower part of the city of Albany was dooded as far back as Green-street. The people were aroused in the night by horsemen riding through the water and knocking on their doors to apprise them of their danger. It was feared that several people had lost their lives. A fire occurred amid the dreadful scene, and the flames burst out from several buildings to increase the consternation, from having to fight two elements at the same time. The wildest confusion prevailed, the people in the lower part of the town having barely time to escape with their lives. The cattle bellowed to the tables, the bells sounded the alarm of fire, and the cries of the people added to the tumult, made it such a night as Albany probably never witness the fore. The entire lower part of Troy, also as high as Fith street was submerged, the bridges gave way and the railroad trains were stopped.
