STANDING RULES

FOR THE

CONSTITUTION AND GOVERNMENT

OF THE

DIOCESAN CHURCH SOCIETY

OF NOVA SCOTIA.

I. His Excellency the LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF NOVA SCOTIA, for the time being, and the SOCIETIES FOR THE PROPAGATION OF THE GOSPEL, and for PROMOTING CHRISTIAN KNOWLEDGE, shall be respectfully requested to be the Patrons of this Society.

II. The Bishop of the Diocese shall be the President of the Society, with a control over all their proceedings. His approval shall be necessary for the completion of all important acts of the Society, and especially for the revocation or alteration of any of the standing rules, and for making any addition to them.

III. There shall be two or more Vice Presidents, of whom the Archdeacon of Nova Scotia shall be the first; a Secretary, an Assistant Secretary, when necessary, and a Treasurer.

IV. There shall be a Standing Committee, consisting of the Officers, all the Clergy, and as many Laymen as it shall be thought convenient to choose at the Annual Meeting of the Society. The Lay Members shall continue in the Committee for a year, or until other Lay Members be chosen in their place; and any or all of them may be re-elected. Seven of the Committee shall be a quorum, provided four of them be Laymen.

V. The Society shall be open to all Members of the Church ; all of whom shall be invited to unite with it. Ten pounds, paid at any one time, shall qualify a person to be a Member during his life; and the payment, in advance, of any sum, *however small*, shall qualify a person to be a Member for a year.

VI. The Members of the Church, in every part of the Province, shall be invited to co-operate with the Diocesan Society, by joining Committees of it, which shall be formed, under the direction of their respective Clergymen, either in each Mission or Parish, or in more than one Mission or Parish united, as shall be deemed most convenient, and in strict accordance with the design and rules of the Diocesan Society ; and it is recommended to the Committees to forward their funds, as they may be collected, to the General Committee, who will faithfully apply them to the general objects of the Society ; but when the Local Committees desire it, they shall receive books, at cost and charges, to the amount of one-fourth of their remittances.

VII. There shall be one General Meeting of the whole Society, including any Members of the Local Committees who can conveniently attend, on such day and at such place as the President may name, of which due notice will be given, with an invitation to every Committee to send at least one Clergyman and two Laymen to represent such Committee, and with a recommendation that each Committee shall meet at some convenient time, immediately before the General Meeting of the Society, that any necessary suggestions may be offered to the representatives of the Committees for their guidance at the General Meeting. And a Special General Meeting may be called at any time and in any place, when the President, or, in his absence, two or more Vice Presidents, shall consider it desirable to appoint such Special General Meeting.

VIII. The objects to which the attention of the Society shall be directed, shall be, generally, those which have engaged the two great Church Societies, in England, for the Propagation of the Gospel, and for Promoting Christian Knowledge, and none other.

IX. The following objects shall more particularly engage the attention of the Society, as soon as their means may enable them to afford such attention :—

1.—Supplies of Books and Tracts from the Stores of the Society for Promoting Christian Knowledge, and none other, except in cases where other books or Tracts, in strict conformity with the principles of the Established Church, and particularly adapted to local circumstances, shall first be carefully examined and approved by a Committee of revision, to be appointed by the General Committee,—the approval of which General Committee shall be necessary in the first place,—after which, the books must likewise receive the written approbation of the Bishop.

- 2.—Missionary visits to neglected and destitute places, under the direction of the Bishop.
- 3.—Upholding, by all possible and proper means, the Collegiate Establishments at Windsor.
- 4.—Assistance to deserving young men, desirous of being qualified for the Ministry of the Church, but requiring aid in pursuing their studies, at the Collegiate Establishment at Windsor.
- 5.—Aid to Sunday and other Schools, in which due attention is paid to instruction in the principles of the Established Church.
- 6.—Encouragement to the instruction and training of respectable Teachers for Sunday and Daily Schools.
- 7.—Assistance to the erection or enlargement of Churches and Chapels belonging to the Established Religion, in peculiar or extreme cases.
- 8.—Assistance to the erection of Parsonage Houses.

To these objects, generally, the general contributions will be applied; while contributors, who desire it, may have their individual contributions scrupulously confined to any one or more of these objects. And as some Members of the Church, who are not unmindful of the great spiritual wants in their own neighbourhood, still feel constrained, in pious gratitude for the blessings they enjoy, to allot something, however small, from the means with which a gracious Providence has blessed them, towards the spread of the glorious Gospel among the nations which still sit in darkness—

X. This Society will gladly receive and forward to the Society for the Propagation of the Gospel, whatever sums may be given for the conversion and instruction of the Heathen,—to which object such sums will be strictly confined by the East India Committee of that Society.

XI. Books and Tracts will generally be on sale, at cost and charges;—and whenever, in particular cases, a deviation from this rule is desired, it must be considered by the Standing Committee, and only permitted when recommended by them and approved by the President, or, in his absence, by two or more of the Vice Presidents.

XII. All Meetings of the Society and of the Committees shall be opened and closed with the prayers used by the two Societies in England, adapted to our situation, under the direction of the Bishop.

TENTH REPORT
 OF THE GENERAL COMMITTEE OF THE
 DIOCESAN CHURCH SOCIETY
 OF NOVA SCOTIA.

THE Annual Meeting of the DIOCESAN CHURCH SOCIETY OF NOVA SCOTIA, took place in the Masonic Hall, at Halifax, on 15th March, 1848, at $7\frac{1}{2}$ o'clock in the evening.

His Excellency Sir JOHN HARVEY took the Chair at $7\frac{1}{2}$ o'clock, and as on former occasions, the proceedings commenced by singing the 100th Psalm.

The Ven. the ARCHDEACON offered up Prayers. His Excellency Sir JOHN HARVEY, in stating the object of the Meeting, urged the claims of the Society with great power and effect, and then called upon the Secretary to read the following

REPORT.

"HITHERTO hath the Lord helped us," said the pious Samuel, when setting up a memorial of the loving kindness of the Lord, on behalf of Israel of old. And hitherto hath the Lord helped us, may we say this evening, met together as we are to rehearse what God has been doing for our Church by means of this Society, during the past year.

The event most deeply affecting the permanent well-being of the Church during this period, and consequently demanding grateful mention in the commencement of our Report, is the brightening prospects of the Collegiate Establishment at Windsor. When last assembled here the friends of that Institution were full of anxiety and apprehension; but by the well-timed and cordial co-operation of her Alumni, encouraged by the munificence of the noble Church Societies in England, whose benevolence and piety first planted, and have long nourished the Colonial Church, those fears are fast giving place to hopeful anticipations; and we humbly trust that this School of the Prophets will soon be placed beyond the reach of accident, and continue to be, as its founders intended, the nursery of Religion and Literature for all time to come.

The past year has also furnished us with an instance of great liberality on the part of a generous member of the Church, who has bestowed a valuable tract of land toward the permanent endowment of the Church in the parish where the property referred to is situated.*

Your Committee deem it right to mention these things, not only in grateful acknowledgment to Him who has put it into the hearts of His people to uphold His Church and her Institutions, but also with the hope that others who possess the means may be encouraged by this example to "go and do likewise."

Another subject upon which the Committee desire to mingle their congratulations with those of their Brethren is the appointment, of Visiting Missionaries for remote and destitute districts. This, though always a favourite object with the Society, was for a length of time delayed and hindered, owing to the difficulty of finding men fitted for the work. Two such men, we humbly trust, have at length been found, one of whom has been stationed by His Lordship the President of the Society, on the Eastern, and the other on the Western Shore of the Province. From both these Missionaries most gratifying reports have already been received by the Committee; and it is our pleasing duty to state, although they have been engaged

in their work but for a few months, and it is our pleasing duty to state, that in their public ministrations, as well as in their efforts to awaken the careless, and comfort the sick and dying from house to house, their first labours have been abundantly appreciated and blessed.

As these Gentlemen are present your Committee deem it unnecessary to say more, but would leave it for themselves to enlist your sympathies, by the recital of the trials and privations to which the Missionary is exposed, the destitution which he must witness, and the hopeful results which the Society may be encouraged to look for, from this "work of faith and labour of love."

And still another cause for thanksgiving may be found in the steady progress which the Church is making, and the growing attachment of her children to this their cherished Institution. Notwithstanding the privations to which our people have been exposed during the past year—a year unprecedented for hardships of various kinds, yet from almost every Parish throughout the Province, the contributions of the faithful have been sent forward; and those who enjoyed the ministrations of the Gospel have not forgotten their less favoured brethren, but have laid up in store for them as God in his goodness has enabled them.

INCOME.

THE following are the Remittances from the Parochial Associations for the past year:—

ANNAPOLIS.—£23.

AYLESFORD.—£22 15, shewing a steady increase of the funds of this Branch of our Society year after year. This includes One Pound from Mr. Wm. Tupper, in aid of Missions to the Heathen.

BRIDGETOWN.—£22. We are glad to find that the zeal in the Society's cause in this Branch is so manifest, the amount remitted this year being nearly double that of last year.

From **CHESTER**—Has been remitted the sum of £17 17 9.— This is a larger sum than that subscribed last year, which Dr. Shreve desires the Committee to regard as an evidence of the growing attachment of his people to the good cause.

From **CORNWALLIS** and **HORTON**—£11 1 10 $\frac{1}{2}$; an increase above that of last year, indicative of the healthy tone of Church feeling in that mission also.

DARTMOUTH.—£22 13 3 $\frac{1}{2}$.

DIGBY.—£20 5. This though less than the remittance of last year, is under the circumstances, highly creditable to the Churchmen of that mission.

GRANVILLE.—£17 5.

LUNENBURGH.—The sum received from this Mission amounts to £25; and the Rev. Mr. Cochran in transmitting it assures us, that if the good wishes of his people could only be converted into cash, we should have nothing to complain of in regard to funds.

ST. CLEMENT'S.—£9.

GUYSBORO'.—£18 0 4½.

YARMOUTH.—£31. This is the largest subscription yet sent forward by the people of this Mission, and reflects credit alike upon the Missionary and the people of his charge.

NEWPORT.—£10 4 4½ same as last year.

SHELBOURNE.—£21 15 2½ inclusive of £5 remitted through the Bishop by the Rev. Dr. Rowland.

PICTOU.—£16 8 9. A sum exceeding the amount remitted last year, and has, the Missionary informs us, been very cheerfully contributed, notwithstanding the depression of trade and the large sum which the Parishioners have subscribed towards the enlargement of their Church.

From TRURO—Has been received £14, inclusive of £4 subscribed by Mr. Leaver to the College.

SACKVILLE.—£9 0 7½.

WEYMOUTH.—£8 10.

WINDSOR.—£21 0 2.

MARGARET'S BAY.—£10, which is highly praiseworthy, considering the many local objects which the Parishioners have on hand.

From LIVERPOOL—Has been received the liberal sum of £32 10, the largest subscription received from any local Branch this year, and most gratifying to the feelings of their devoted Pastor.

EASTERN SHORE.—From this place the Rev. Mr. Jamieson has again sent forward £23 as a contribution from his honest hearted fishermen and sailors. This tho' in appearance smaller, is in reality

a more liberal subscription than that of last year, inasmuch as some of the settlements then under his charge have formed themselves into a separate Association, and subscribed through Mr. Breading.

MAHONE BAY.—£9.

At WALLACE—An auxiliary branch has been formed by Rev. R. Avery, lately appointed to that mission, and £7 16 7 remitted as their first tribute to the good cause.

NEW DUBLIN.—The Rev. Mr. Brine has been appointed to this Mission during the past year, organized a Branch, and remitted the handsome sum of £13 5 10 $\frac{1}{2}$.

MANCHESTER.—In this District lately separated from Guysboro' and made a distinct mission, the Rev. W. T. Morris has organized a branch, and sent forward as a first remittance £6 0 2.

From **AMHERST**.—Where the burden of building a handsome and expensive brick Church is still in some measure pressing on the people, has been received £10.

ANTIGONISHE.—This Parish now under the charge of the Rev. A. W. Millidge, has resumed its former missionary attitude, and remitted for the present year £17 6 7 $\frac{1}{2}$.

FALKLAND.—From this place the Ven. the Archdeacon reports a subscription of £18 14 1, to be paid in half yearly instalments; £9 7 0 $\frac{1}{2}$ of which has been already paid.

From **SALMON RIVER, BEAVER HARBOUR, AND NOODY QUODDY**, the Rev. Mr. Breading has remitted £6 4 6 $\frac{1}{2}$.

From **BARRINGTON, WESTPORT AND SANDY COVE**, the Rev. Mr. Forsyth has handed in £8 13 5 $\frac{1}{2}$.

The Subscriptions and Contributions above enumerated amount to £798 3 3 $\frac{1}{2}$.

EXPENDITURE.

SCHOOLS.—The Society have now in operation three Church Schools, one at Chester receiving an annual grant of £20; one at Weymouth, and one at Margaret's Bay, receiving yearly £10 each.—The expenditure under this head during the past year has been £30.

VISITING MISSIONARIES.—The Committee rejoice to think that the expenditure in this department of the Society's benevolent operations is likely to be largely increased. Two Missionaries are already engaged by the Society, and entered upon their work with encouraging success, at a salary of £150, together with travelling expenses; and a member of the General Committee has given notice of his intention to move at no distant day, for the employment of six additional Missionaries, to be supported in part from the funds of this Society, himself guaranteeing the salary of one such Missionary.

The expenditure for missionary objects during the past year, including £20 granted to the Ven. the Archdeacon to meet missionary visits in Cape Breton, amounts to £138 10.

CHURCHES.—In this department £165 have been expended, and assistance thus afforded in the erection or enlargement of eleven Churches, several of which could not have been completed but for the well timed aid of the Society.

The Churches assisted and the amount granted to each, will appear in Treasurer's Account appended to this Report.

STUDENTS AT WINDSOR.—Three young Gentlemen Students at Windsor College, have availed themselves of the assistance which the Society holds out for the encouragement of the pious and deserving who may need its aid while qualifying themselves for the sacred Ministry at that University. One of these is now ordained, and gives promise of being an active and useful Missionary. The other two are still pursuing their studies with a view to Holy Orders.—Sum expended £70 15.

BOOKS.—As in former years the local Committees have generally availed themselves of the privilege of receiving back in books the amount of one fourth of their remittance.

There has been paid into the Book fund during the past year on this account, together with some special grants, the sum of £109 7 11. The particulars are given at large in the Treasurer's Account appended to this Report.

There has been issued from the Depository of the Society during the part year, 70 Bibles, 200 Testaments, 1,080 Prayer Books, 4,997 Tracts, 1,218 bound Books, and other Publications.

MISCELLANEOUS.—During the past year there has been paid for defraying the expenses of printing the Report, collecting subscriptions, the Depository's salary, and amounts directed to be paid to the Treasurer of King's College, &c. £111 8 2*½*.

The disbursements for the past year have thus amounted to £627 11 1*½*.

The Committee cannot conclude this Report without making an earnest appeal to the members of our Holy Communion, especially in this City, for increased liberality in this the day of the Church's trial and need. That our lot is cast in a day of opposition and rebuke is known to all, and felt by most of us. Our Zion has enemies on every side, for her warfare is not accomplished, and every year seems to add to their boldness and their virulence. And when the enemies of our Church thus combine to accomplish her ruin, shall not her friends unite their efforts to uphold and protect her; when the cry of the adversary is—"down with her to the dust," shall not her devoted children unite, that by persevering prayer, and combined effort, and cheerful unwearying support, they may make her what her Divine constitution has fitted her to be, and her Divine Head has intended her to be, a joy and a praise in the earth.

As a Church we are set not only for the defence of the truth, but also for the spread of the truth,—not only to preserve it but also to propagate it,—and never does the Church discharge her sacred trust so well, as when ceasing to act upon the defensive, she plants the standard of her great Captain on territories not hitherto possessed. And never does the lamp of the Church dispense such gladdening light as when it illumines the dark places, where the people are perishing because there is no vision. And never do the strong holds of error so totter to their basis, as when the "trumpet of Jubilee is the weapon of assault."

The Report having been read—

The LORD BISHOP moved the first Resolution, viz.:

I.—*Resolved*, That the Report just read, be received, printed, and circulated under the direction of the General Committee.

Which being seconded by the Hon. H. G. PINO, M. L. C. was agreed to.

The Rev. Mr. BULLOCK moved the second Resolution :

II.—*Resolved*, That while we rejoice in the success which has attended the labours of our first Visiting Missionaries, and desire to express our gratitude to God; we trust it will serve as an effective call for the increased exertions of the Church throughout the Province to send forth more labourers into the harvest.

Which was seconded by the Hon. CHIEF JUSTICE, and passed.

The ATTORNEY GENERAL moved the third Resolution :

III.—*Resolved*, That as the Church must mainly depend for labourers in the Lord's Vineyard upon the supply to be derived from the College at Windsor, this meeting hails with gratitude the munificent offers of the Society for Promoting Christian Knowledge, to which we are already so largely indebted, in so liberally responding to the call of the Right Rev. the Visitor, addressed to them in behalf of the Institution, and calls upon the members of the Church at large to give their liberal aid to the exertions now making by them, the Bishop, and the Associated Alumni, on its behalf.

Which was seconded by the Rev. Mr. LEAVER, and agreed to.

The Rev. Mr. OWEN proposed the fourth Resolution :

IV.—*Resolved*, That this Society has seen with great gratification the success which has attended the efforts of the Sister Societies in the neighbouring Colonies; and they trust that the members of the Church in Nova Scotia will exert themselves to the utmost to enable this Society to carry on the good work, in which we are all engaged, on the same liberal scale.

Which was seconded by HENRY PRYOR, Esq., and passed.

The Rev. R. ARNOLD moved the fifth Resolution :

V.—*Resolved*, That the establishment of four Episcopal Sees during the past year—three on the Australian Continent, and one at the Cape of Good Hope, is an event wisely calculated under God to strengthen the stakes and lengthen the cords of our Apostolic Church, and consequently demanding the devout gratitude of all who wish well to our Zion.

Which was seconded by A. M. UNIACKE, Esq., and passed.

The Rev. R. F. UNIACKE moved the sixth Resolution :

VI.—*Resolved*, That the following Members of this Society be elected Members of the Standing Committee for the ensuing year:—J. S. Morris, Esq., to be one of the Vice Presidents, in place of the Honble. T. N. Jeffery, deceased. Joseph Starr, Esq., A. M. Uniacke, Esq., Henry Ince, Esq., B. Murdoch, Esq., Mr. James Fenerty, J. G. A. Creighton, Esq., James Tremain, Esq., Mr. W. A. McAgv, C. H. Belcher, Esq., Honble. M. B. Almon, Hon. Mr. Justice Bliss, Dr. Henry, P. M. O. E. Albro, Esq., W. H. Roach, Esq., Mr. W. Which was seconded by the PROVINCIAL TREASURER, and passed.

APPENDIX.

As great inconvenience has resulted from the general practice of the Local Branches, in delaying too long the sending forward of their Reports, the following Resolution was passed at a General Meeting held on 18th Feby., 1847 :

Resolved, That in order to ensure the insertion of the proceedings of the Local Committees in the Annual Report of the Society, it will be necessary that their Contributions and Report should be sent forward on or before the 31st. day of Decr., in each year.

Inconvenience having been experienced also by the General Committee from the want of attention to the following particulars, the notice of the Presidents and Officers of Local Committees is particularly requested to them, viz. :—

The General Committee meets in Halifax on the third Friday in each month, from November to May inclusive ; and all applications for aid should be forwarded to the Secretary, at least a week before either of those dates.

Every application for aid should contain the following information, in defect of which the application must be postponed for fuller particulars :

For aid in the erection of a Church—

- 1.—The precise situation, specially with reference to the nearest Place of Worship, and to the amount of population within five miles of the Church.
- 2.—The Title of the Ground, on which the building is to be erected.
- 3.—The size of the building ; the numbers it can accommodate ; and probable amount of the congregation that will usually attend it.
- 4.—The supposed cost of the building ; the progress it has made towards completion ; and the amount of contributions on the spot in money or labour.

The following Resolutions in reference to Church Schools, were drawn up by a Sub-Committee appointed for that purpose on the 17th of March last :

Resolved, That the General Committee of this Society having reconsidered the regulations under which the Grants to Church Schools shall hereafter be allowed,

It has been determined that the Schools already aided shall receive their usual grants for the current year ; and that in future no schools shall receive assistance from this Society, but such as comply with the conditions following —

First.—That the School House be erected on ground, the title of which, with the buildings and appurtenances, is duly secured to the S. P. G., the Bishop of the Diocese, or the Church Corporation of the Parish.

Second.—That the Church Catechism be taught in the School, and other religious instruction given in accordance with the principles of the Church, and under the direction of the Missionary.

Third.—That no application for aid to Day Schools shall be considered at any Meeting of

the General Committee, unless the Parish or District shall have subscribed and secured in addition to any public aid, at least the sum of £40, towards defraying the salary of the Schoolmaster.

Fifth.—That any Parish or District complying with the foregoing conditions shall be entitled to receive one fourth of the sum, subscribed and secured as above, from the funds of this Society, so far as its means will allow.

Fifth.—That all grants to Schools shall be deemed and considered to be annual.

Sixth.—That every application shall contain the following information :

I.—The title to the Ground on which the School House is erected.

II.—The situation of the School as regards the nearest adjoining School.

III.—The number of Scholars in usual attendance, and the general circumstances of their Parents.

IV.—Is the Church Catechism taught, and the School generally conducted with a due regard to the principles of the Established Church ?

V.—The nature of the aid required ; whether books, assistance towards Master's salary, &c.

VI.—The qualifications and religious profession of the Master, and the branches which he is capable of teaching.
