B., was the owner. They were accompanied by a chart, mapping out the location. They sailed from St. John's on the 15th of August, reaching the island a thorough search was made, but without success, and the expedition returned to St. John's, leaving behind Whidden and a German named Giesman, who eventually overpowered the treasure.
