**An Act to amend the Representation Act by allowing  
two Members to the County of Peel.**

**W**HEREAS the population and extent of Territory of the County of Peel is such as to render it desirable that the representation of that County in the Provincial Parliament should be increased; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows: Preamble.

- 5 I. After the passing of this Act, the said County of Peel shall be entitled and required, at the first general election of representatives to serve in the said Provincial Parliament, or on the first vacancy in the representation of the said County, to elect and return two fit and proper persons to represent the said County in the Legislative Assembly. Two members allowed to Peel after the first vacancy in its representation.
