AN APPEAL TO CHRISTIAN CHARITY FROM THE NEWFOUNDLANDERS.

The following circular is being largely distributed:

It is with mingled feelings of the deepest distress and regret that we have to appeal to the benevolence for support in our great emergency.

We remember your hearty and practical charity at a time when the fire devoured our city and rendered thousands homeless and destitute.

That calamity, however, was slight, compared to the present one. St. John's alone suffered to the extent of \$1,000,000.

St. John's alone is affected to the extent of \$1,000,000. The results indeed are already appalling.

The difficulty and needs are daily increasing. It is as well calculated that at the present moment 1,000 families in St. John's alone are seeking relief.

A number of women, are daily increasing—but the greatest fear and apprehension exist that these numbers will be magnified by an influx from the neighboring growing cry of want in the more distant sections of the province.

Usually, the Government, under circumstances of public distress, provide words of relief, but the same course operate upon us, and they are unable to adopt any adequate remedial measures.

The local charities are doing and have done much, but their resources are limited.

Our leading object, our leading object is to appeal to the general public, ever ready to respond to such personal sacrifice, are themselves suffering from the same calamity.

Labour has been largely curtailed and a long and arduous winter is before us.

The loss of the ship and industries are either completely lost or so depreciated in value that many who never knew want will need assistance.

It is with such circumstances as these we are called upon to give aid.

Indeed, there lie before us all the conditions of distress that touch the quick human heart.

And therefore we appeal to those "who love their fellowmen" to respond with what liberty they may to our call in this our hour of need and trying need.
