RETURN OF MR. HARRY CORBY

Belleville Ex-M.P. Has Been Enjoying the Health Waters of Carlsbad, Austria.

Discusses Marconi's Invention

Not Many Who Are Skeptical of Its Immediate Usefulness for Commercial Purposes.

Mr. Harry Corby, ex-M.P., has returned from his trip to the Continent, feeling very much improved in health. He was met at New York upon his return by Mrs. and Miss Corby, who are at present with him in the city, as guests at the Rossin.

Since his departure some months ago he has spent most of the time at Carlsbad, Austria, one of the most renowned health resorts on the Continent. The inhabitants of Carlsbad number from seven thousand to eight thousand, but during the summer months there were no less than 54,000 visitors there, all making good use of the baths and including freely in walking through the extensive pine groves in the country surrounding.

Mr. Corby's return voyage was the roughest the oceanic had since she was launched a few years ago, but it did not seem to affect the big vessel very much. While going from Ostend to Dover he had the pleasure of a conversation with the president of Marconi's company, who expressed great confidence in the practical utility of the wireless telegraph system. In London, however, Mr. Corby came in contact with quite a number of men who had given the system some attention, and who were skeptical of its immediate usefulness for commercial purposes. They all admitted, though, that there was a likelihood of improvement which would make it a formidable competitor of the cable.

Mr. Corby will return to his home in Belleville in the course of a few days. He was accompanied on his trip by Mr. F. R. Lingham of Belleville, whom he left at London, and who is now leaving shortly for South Africa to look after his lumbering and mining interests.

CYCLING MAGAZINES IN NEW YORK

Association Hands Out Decisions—Tom Bek Has Trouble Over Track

New York, Feb. 4.—The annual meeting of the National Cycling Association was held in this city today. Frank Blinn of Baltimore presided. The American Bicycle Cyclists' Union was represented by Frank L. Kramer, the professional champion of 1901, and representatives from tracks and clubs all over the country were in attendance. The Board of Appeals made the following rulings:

In the case of Jay Eaton, who was suspended for life on a charge of crooked riding at Valhalla, N.Y., the sentence was reduced to two years suspension. This will expire next fall.

The report of the Board of Control showed that the year 1901 was the most successful enjoyed for several years. Over 700 teams were held and 4,000 races were distributed in prizes.

Kramer, American Cycling Union, Detroit, was elected president of the National Association of Professional Cyclists. A. Neuhard was elected secretary. The committee on franchises in 1902 recommended that franchises be divided into three classes: professional, conditional and temporary. The report was accepted.
